ORDINANCE NO. 4815

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHANDLER, ARIZONA, FORMING A 2020 CENSUS COMPLETE COUNT COMMITTEE TO GUIDE EFFORTS TO OBTAIN A SUCCESSFUL AND ACCURATE COMPLETE COUNT.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council desire to promote and develop community outreach for the Chandler 2020 Census in a manner that is inclusive and representative of the needs and desires of Chandler's citizens; and

WHEREAS, a 2020 Census Complete Count Committee is deemed necessary by the Mayor and City Council to guide efforts of the 2020 Census; and

WHEREAS, the 2020 Census Complete Count Committee is considered to be a Public Body as defined by Arizona Revised Statues, and therefore, any meeting of the 2020 Census Complete Count Committee is subject to the Arizona Open Meeting Law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Chandler, Arizona, as follows:

SECTION I. A 2020 Census Complete Count Committee, comprised of (14) members shall be formed to guide staff and community efforts in the promotion and outreach of the 2020 Census. The Mayor shall nominate committee members with the approval of the City Council as provided for in Article VI. of the Charter for the City of Chandler.

SECTION II. The 2020 Census Complete Count Committee shall sunset after the completion and final results of the 2020 Census.
