Program Description

The Hershey National Track and Field Youth Program is to promote physical fitness and participation for the youth of America. **Please read the Eligibility, Rules and Advancement Section of this Entry Form carefully.** Questions concerning this section should be referred to the City of Chandler Recreation Division, **Ken Sipes, Track Meet Director at 480-782-2704** Para mas información, favor de llamar a **480-782-2704.**

Eligibility

- A. The intent of the Hershey National Track & Field Youth Program is to provide a basic playground form of participation for the beginning athlete.
- B. Eligible children must compete in the program in the state in which they reside. Any eligible child who lives outside the jurisdiction of a local sponsoring agency in his or her state may participate in the program with the permission of the agency. A participant may enter only one local or district meet.
- C. Any questions regarding eligibility will first be referred to the state chairperson. If the question is unresolved, it shall then be presented to the regional coordinator. If the regional coordinator is unable to resolve the question, it shall be presented to the National Director. The ruling of the National Director is final.
- D. Any child, age 6-14, living or attending school in the City of Chandler, is eligible to compete in this local meet.

Rules

- 1. Each participant **must provide physical proof of birth date** prior to competition at the **district/state level.**
- 2. Each participant must submit a completed 2010 **Entry Form, including signatures, prior to participation** in an entry-level meet.
- 3. Each participant must compete in the **proper age group.**
- 4. Each participant shall compete in **one event only** at the **District Level.**
- 5. Each participant **must wear shoes** while competing in an event.
- 6. Spikes, hard-cleated shoes, shoes made to take spikes or cleats, and starting blocks are **not permitted.**
- 7. Participants can and shall be **disqualified** from further competition if they are found to be in **violation** of any part of the Eligibility and Rules section; or if they fail to participate under the **basic intent** of the Hershey National Track & Field Youth Program.

*Notice: Proof of Birth date Documentation (Rule 1)

Participants and their parents or guardians should be aware that **physical documentation** of participant's date of birth **must be submitted prior** to participant's advancement to a **District Championship Meet.**

Failure to submit the required proof of birth date documentation, prior to district advancement, can be cause for disqualifying a participant from the program. **A copy of participant's birth certificate or baptismal record are the only forms of documentation acceptable as proof of birth.**
