In addition, we welcome and encourage persons with disabilities to participate in our general recreation and aquatics classes, programs and activities. We are committed to the letter, spirit, and intent of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), and to:

- Maintaining accessible facilities, classes, programs and activities;
- Promoting inclusion through reasonable accommodations;
- Striving to make the recreational experience a positive and successful one for all.

If an individual requires assistance in order to successfully participate in one of our classes, programs or activities a reasonable accommodation should be requested.

Completion and submission and of the Request for Accommodation form, at least two weeks prior to the beginning of a class, program or activity, is requested to allow City staff to review the request and make the necessary arrangements to accommodate qualified individuals with disabilities who otherwise meet program eligibility requirements.
