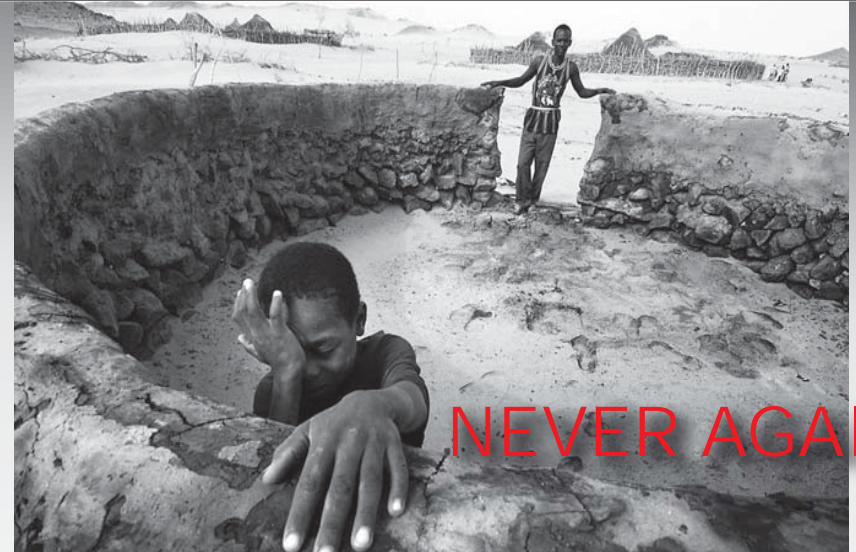

This exhibit at the Barness Family JCC includes Life Masks of Holocaust survivors and concentration camp liberators along with their stories and historical documentation on a panel display and accompanied by corresponding artwork.
