RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends Council forward a recommendation for approval of a Special Event Liquor License for the Chandler Cultural Foundation, and further, that approval be given for the City of Chandler Special Event Liquor License.

DISCUSSION

An application for a Special Event Liquor License has been submitted by the Chandler Cultural Foundation for a fundraising event featuring Rita Coolidge on Saturday, February 19, 2011 from 6:30 p.m. until 9:30 p.m. at the Chandler Center for the Arts, 250 N. Arizona Avenue.

With a Special Event Liquor License the organization can sell all alcoholic beverages within the confines of the event during the designated event periods.

The Police Department reports no objections to the issuance of this license. As this applicant is a non-profit organization, no sales tax license is required; however, the special event liquor fee has been paid.
