RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends Council forward a recommendation for approval of a Special Event Liquor License for the Chandler Chamber of Commerce, and further, that approval be given for the City of Chandler Special Event Liquor License.

DISCUSSION

An application for a Special Event Liquor License has been submitted by the Chandler Chamber of Commerce for the Ostrich Festival on Friday, March 11, 2011 from 2:00 p.m. until 12:00 a.m. midnight; Saturday, March 12, 2011 from 10:00 a.m. until 12:00 a.m. midnight; Sunday, March 13, 2011 from 10:00 a.m. until 11:00 p.m. at Tumbleweed Park, 2250 S. McQueen Rd.

With a Special Event Liquor License the organization can sell all alcoholic beverages within the confines of the event during the designated event periods.


The Police Department reports no objections to the issuance of this license. As this applicant is a non-profit organization, no sales tax license is required; however, the special event liquor fee has been paid.
