RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends Council forward a recommendation for approval of a Special Event Liquor License for the Chandler Lions Club, and further, that approval be given for the City of Chandler Special Event Liquor License.

DISCUSSION

An application for a Special Event Liquor License has been submitted by the Chandler Lions Club for the Train Revival Music Festival on Saturday, April 23, 2011 from 4:00 p.m. until 12:00 a.m. at Tumbleweed Park, 2250 S. McQueen Road.

With a Special Event Liquor License the organization can sell all alcoholic beverages within the confines of the event during the designated event periods.

The Police Department reports no objections to the issuance of this license. As this applicant is a non-profit organization no sales tax license is required; however the special event liquor fee has been paid.
