SUBJECT: LUP11-0002 SIDELINES GRILL AND TAVERN

- Request:** Use Permit approval to allow the addition of live music on an outdoor patio at an existing restaurant in conjunction with a Series 12 (Restaurant) liquor license
- Location:** 2980 S. Alma School Road, Suite #2, west of the northwest corner of Queen Creek and Alma School Roads
- Applicants:** Sidelines Tavern and Grill Corporation/
Arizona Liquor Industry Consultants

RECOMMENDATION

Planning Commission and Staff, finding consistency with the General Plan and Planned Area Development (PAD) zoning, recommend approval for one (1) year, subject to conditions.

BACKGROUND

The restaurant is located west of the northwest corner of Alma School and Queen Creek Roads within the Ocotillo Plaza shopping center that contains a Target and a vacant Basha’s grocery store. The restaurant occupies the southern end of a pad building along Queen Creek Road. The existing Use Permit, most recently approved in 2009 without a time limit, does not allow for any live music either indoors or outdoors. The subject request is to add live music on the outdoor patio.

The restaurant has an estimated seating of 202 persons, including 60 seats on a 1,150 square foot outdoor patio along its southeastern wall. The patio is enclosed with 36-inch tall decorative railing and includes a fireplace and six televisions. The restaurant has been in operation since 2002 (always under a Series 12 Restaurant License) and is open Sunday and Monday from 11 a.m. to 11 p.m., Tuesday through Thursday from 11 a.m. to 12 a.m., and 11 a.m. to 1 a.m. on Fridays and Saturdays.

The application requests live music on the outdoor patio from 7 to 10 p.m. on Thursdays and weekends, though with the flexibility to occasionally change the days and times. The music had been occurring in late 2010 and early 2011 in violation of the existing Use Permit until neighbor complaints led city staff to take enforcement action. The music has reportedly stopped since the subject application was filed in mid-February. The application lists three musical acts as anticipated performers, each with only one or two persons. The musicians use a pair of 110-watt, 12" speakers for amplification that are pointed toward the building.

The restaurant first received a Use Permit in 2002. It received a new Use Permit in 2009 to accommodate a patio expansion.

A Series 12 Restaurant License allows the on-site sale of beer, wine, and spirits for on-premise consumption. Under a typical Series 12 license the establishment must derive at least 40 percent of its gross revenue from the sale of food and non-alcoholic beverages.

DISCUSSION

Planning Commission and Staff recommend approval of the request with a time limit of one (1) year to allow for re-evaluation and with conditions that limit the noise level, including that music shall not exceed the ambient (most likely traffic) noise level as measured at the property line. The outdoor music that has been played previously would not satisfy these conditions because it was heard plainly above the ambient noise level across Queen Creek Road to the south. In order to satisfy the recommended conditions, the restaurant will have to decrease speaker volume at a minimum (compared to the noisier nights that led to complaints) and perhaps change to unamplified acoustic music. Also, the restaurant shall maintain a liaison program so that residents may reach a responsible person at any time about noise concerns, leading to a quick resolution of the problem (turn the volume down, etc.).

PUBLIC/NEIGHBORHOOD NOTIFICATION

- This request was noticed in accordance with the requirements of the Chandler Zoning Code.
- A neighborhood meeting was held on March 30, 2011 at the Downtown Community Center. Approximately 15 neighbors attended. One neighbor was opposed, three concerned or there for information, and the rest in favor. One of the musicians who has played at the restaurant also attended, testifying that his music is about 80 decibels according to his phone app (about the same level as a car from 25 feet away). The restaurant owner gave a presentation, explaining the desire to have one- and two-man bands a few nights a month on the patio or inside (space permitting), but with no dance floor. She expressed a desire to maintain a family atmosphere and increase business despite the retail center's struggles. No security guards are needed or desired.

Neighbors debated the level of music during previous performances. One person who lives about 700 feet away reports never hearing the music. Two people who live about 870 feet away report hearing the music outdoors but not indoors on a few occasions. One person who lives about 1,300 feet away reports hearing the music indoors on three occasions, but not every time it was played. Several others who also live more than 1,000 feet away report never hearing the music. Some neighbors expressed support for the restaurant because it is a positive local business that is good for the area. A couple neighbors expressed a desire that the music “not happen all the time”.

- The Police Department has been informed of the application and has not responded with any issues or concerns.
- Staff has been contacted by three residents in opposition to outdoor music. The residents all live south of Queen Creek Road in the Stillwater Cove at Ocotillo neighborhood. Also, a petition circulated by one of these three residents, and signed by 30 persons, is among the memo attachments. The petition opposes outdoor music for reasons including loss of “quiet, peace and serenity”, lack of buildings between the patio and the neighborhood, and the anticipated negative effect on property values.
- The Ocotillo Community Association’s Board of Directors has written a letter (among the memo attachments) in support of the opposing neighbors’ efforts and concerns.
- The applicants have provided a petition of support signed by approximately 110 neighbors and restaurant patrons. One neighbor also wrote a letter of support. These documents are among the memo attachments.
- A survey of 19 neighbors was provided by a supporting neighbor that indicates 17 neighbors have heard no music on their properties and 2 neighbors heard music, but it was not “bothersome”. The completed surveys are among the memo attachments.

PLANNING COMMISSION VOTE REPORT

Motion to Approve:

In Favor: 7 Opposed: 0

Planning Commission revised Condition No. 10 to allow later hours for music on Friday and Saturday, though earlier hours on Thursday and Sunday (Staff recommendation had initially been 10 p.m. cut-off every day). Commission heard testimony from the applicants and several neighbors. A couple neighbors spoke in support. Three other neighbors had been in opposition, but are apparently not opposed if the recommended conditions are abided by. Another neighbor was particularly concerned about the hours of music. All the neighbors who spoke live in the Stillwater Cove neighborhood. The applicants asked for later hours on Friday and Saturday to accommodate the later typical dinner hours on those days.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

Planning Commission and Staff, upon finding consistency with the General Plan, recommend approval of the Use Permit subject to the following conditions:

1. The Use Permit granted is for a Series 12 license only, and any change of license shall require reapplication and new Use Permit approval.

2. Expansion beyond the approved Floor Plan shall void the Use Permit and require new Use Permit application and approval.
3. Any substantial change in the floor plan to include such items as, but not limited to, additional bar serving area or the addition of entertainment related uses shall require reapplication of the Use Permit.
4. Expansion or modification beyond the approved exhibits (Floor Plan and Narrative) shall void the Use Permit and require new Use Permit application and approval.
5. The Use Permit is non-transferable to any other store location.
6. The patio and area adjacent to the restaurant entrance shall be maintained in a clean and orderly manner.
7. The Use Permit shall remain in effect for one (1) year from the effective date of City Council approval. Continuation of the Use Permit beyond the expiration date shall require re-application to and approval by the City of Chandler.
8. Outdoor music shall not utilize bass speakers or sub-woofers.
9. The maximum diameter of speakers used in conjunction with outdoor music shall be 12".
10. Music shall not be played after 10 p.m. on Thursdays and Sundays nor after 11:30 p.m. on Fridays and Saturdays. Music shall not be played before 9 a.m. on any day.
11. Music shall be limited to Thursday through Sunday.
12. Music shall be controlled so as to not unreasonably disturb area residences and shall not exceed the ambient noise level as measured at the commercial property line.
13. The restaurant shall provide contact information for a responsible person (restaurant owner and/or manager) to interested neighbors that allows music complaints to be resolved quickly and directly.

PROPOSED MOTION

Move to approve Use Permit LUP11-0002 SIDELINES GRILL AND TAVERN, subject to the conditions recommended by Planning Commission and Staff.




Vicinity Map






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

Sidelines Grill & Tavern is an existing restaurant located at 2980 S. Alma School Road Suite 2 in Chandler within the Ocotillo Plaza Shopping Center. Sidelines Grill & Tavern has already qualified and holds a series 12 restaurant liquor license and has a Chandler Liquor Use Permit already in place but we would like to request permission to add live entertainment.

Sideline's Grill & Tavern currently holds a series 12 restaurant liquor license (12075162) and is open for business Sunday & Monday 11am until 11pm, Tuesday & Thursday 11am until 12am and Friday & Saturday 11am until 1am. Sidelines is a family friendly sports grill with a menu that consists of hamburgers, chicken, pizza, fish, salads and appetizers (menu attached). We currently employ 30 people. Our interior square footage is 2,652 and our patio is 800 and has total seating of 202 inside and out. Our parking is not assigned by the property manager; it is shared with other businesses.

Sidelines Grill and Tavern would like to add live entertainment to their business. The live entertainment would consist of a one or two man acoustic band to be located on the patio. The entertainers use 2 110 watt speakers that are 12 inches and are attached to their microphone. They are never louder than the Suns playing on our television speakers out on the patio. The speakers are plugged into the guitar and are pointed inside the restaurant. The performers have offered to come to our meeting with their equipment to demonstrate the sound levels. The live music will be mostly Thursday evenings 7pm till 10pm and on weekends although we may occasionally change days and times. The following bands are what we are considering: Desert Dixie, a two man band that plays country music. Alan Dequina, a

one man band that plays rock and roll oldies. Curt and Rod, a two man band that plays mostly country, top hits, Neil Diamond etc. any

Dear City Council Members and Planning and Zoning Commissioners:

We reside in and own or lease property in the neighborhood south of Queen Creek Road, west of Alma School . We are in the Stillwater Cove area of the Ocotillo Development. This is a quiet, established, single family residential neighborhood with many of the properties backing up to the Ocotillo Golf Course and the lakes in Ocotillo.

It has come to our attention that the Sidelines Grill and Tavern is requesting that the City allow them to amend their Liquor Use Permit to include live bands and live music on their patio. It is our understanding that their current Liquor Use Permit was granted on the basis of Sidelines bar not having *any* live music, inside or outside, and that this Liquor Use Permit currently does not allow any live music.

Recently, on several occasions, Sidelines Grill and Tavern has already hired bands to play outdoor music (in violation of their Liquor Use Permit), which, because it produced a disturbance in the neighborhood, came to the attention of the Chandler Police Department and the Code Enforcement Division of the City of Chandler.

We, the undersigned are opposed to the City allowing Sidelines Grill and Tavern to have outdoor bands at their bar for the following reasons:

- Their patio faces to the south which will project the sound to the south, disturbing an established, quiet neighborhood;
- There are insufficient buildings or buffers between the Sidelines bar's patio and the Stillwater Cove neighborhood to the south. The music will (and already has) projects to the south into the neighborhood.
- The bands that Sidelines has *already* hired to play on their patio have disturbed the neighborhood – in violation of their Liquor Use Permit - projecting noise to as far south as Honeysuckle Lane, where the noise could be heard inside the house, with the door and windows closed;
- In the past, this neighborhood has worked hard to prevent a different sports bar from locating in the Albertson's Center at the southeast quadrant of Alma School and Queen Creek Roads and Walmart from locating in the northeast quadrat of Alma School and

Queen Creek, due to our concern that these businesses would be unfavorable and incompatible businesses for the neighborhood;

- Ocotillo is one of Chandler's planned residential communities that is mentioned with pride in describing Chandler's well laid out and family friendly neighborhoods. Allowing a bar to have live outdoor bands this close to this single family residential community would tarnish not only the area, but also the image that Chandler is seeking to project.
- Some of the benefits of living in Ocotillo, which is reflected in the property values, is to be able to enjoy the quiet, peace and serenity of living near or on one of the lakes, the golf courses, or one of the open green spaces, or to be able to experience sitting outdoors in a quiet environment. This would be destroyed each evening by the projecting of loud music into the neighborhood.
- Property values in the neighborhood would be damaged and decreased when the neighborhood is subjected music from the bar.

We request that the Planning and Zoning Commission make a recommendation to the City Council members to stand by the original Liquor Use Permit that did not allow live music at the Sidelines Grill and Tavern. We request the Chandler City Council not allow this amendment for live outdoor bands or music at the Sidelines Grill and Tavern.



Mayor Tibshraeny and Council,

Thank you for the opportunity to write you regarding an upcoming agenda item for Council and Planning and Zoning. I would have liked to present this in person at the Council meeting tonight, but unfortunately cannot attend due to work schedule.

First a quick background on me. I worked for the City of Chandler for 8 years before accepting a promotion to work for another municipality. I am very thankful for the opportunities afforded me during my career and think of the City of Chandler and its employees fondly. I still reside in Chandler and am active in my community through church, youth sports, adult sports, etc. Throughout my career and residency, this is my first ever letter to Council.

I write to you today regarding a petition I read concerning Sidelines Grill. It is my understanding a citizen has begun this petition due to a concern about outdoor music at Sidelines. I'll quote the petition, "This noise will change our peaceful, quiet family-oriented community, and could affect property values!!" In my opinion, the entire petition misleads its readers with words like bar, outdoor bands, general disturbance, band noise, etc. Further description states, "The band noise was audible inside a house as far away as on Honeysuckle Lane, with the doors and windows closed. The police were called, and that is now why the bar is attempting to get a permit to have the bands regularly." This petition paints a picture to its readers that Sidelines is an unruly bar without regard for its neighbors, unlawful, and an antagonist to our family-oriented community.

It is also my understanding this petition was created by the City of Chandler Real Estate Coordinator, Sharon Joyce.

I am writing to show support of Sidelines Grill with facts and personal experience from working and living in Chandler and more specifically the Ocotillo area. Last year Sidelines Grill invested its own financial streams into upgrading their patio area. It was refreshing to see positive change on the North/West corner of Alma School and Queen Creek roads. That particular corner has lost Basha's and is about to lose its other anchor store in Target later this year. With the exception of Taco Bell and Arby's, no other restaurant has survived the economic changes. Numerous other smaller retail facilities have also closed or moved out. So far Sidelines Grill has been able to not only survive the economic change but in fact, invest in itself to improve their business model and customer experience.

In my opinion, Sidelines Grill is a family-oriented establishment. I have a young family. We frequent Sidelines Grill often. They have a children's menu, pleasant employees, candy and toy machines, quality food and an overall very clean environment. Even though the TV's are primarily for sporting events, my 5 year old is given a remote control to change the closest TV to cartoons! The walls are decorated with our professional sports team items as well as local High School memorabilia as well. Throughout Sidelines Grill are trophies from all of the local athletic teams that are sponsored by them. They advertise in most of the local periodicals, supporting their economy as well. It is a family run business and the owners also live in Chandler. They

are positive members of our community, good neighbors, shown longevity, support Chandler tax revenues and have added value to an otherwise struggling corner. In my opinion they should be treated with respect not a petition circulated by one of the City of Chandler employees. In particular, the Real Estate Coordinator.

Mrs. Joyce has a concern about the music that will be played at Sidelines Grill. Yet establishments such as D'Vine and Living Room also have comfortable patios and live music as well. These other establishments are also within a square mile of Honeysuckle Lane. I don't see the difference. The petition states, "This noise will change our peaceful, quiet family-oriented community, and could affect property values!!" My question to Mrs. Joyce would simply be the following:

Name one establishment more family oriented, gives back to their community and has taken action to actually raise property value in the Ocotillo area? I challenge her or anyone who may have signed the petition to think of just one.

As a former employee and current resident of Chandler I will add that I don't believe Sharon Joyce is acting within the best interest of the city. I believe she is utilizing her position to harass Sidelines Grill and coercing neighbors into signing a petition. It is my understanding that she is a nuisance to her neighborhood and has filed numerous police complaints for a variety of personal interests.

The City of Chandler has tried for years to keep its own residents and their tax dollars here. Upgrading our downtown and working to become a better dining experience destination than a Scottsdale or Tempe. We are doing so much better. Let's keep it up!

I fully support a Planning and Zoning change to allow Sidelines Grill to offer live music as a part of their business model.




