5. SUBJECT: Approve use of U.S. Communities contract No. 11019-RFP with Home Depot and HD Supply Maintenance Solutions for the purchase of maintenance and hardware supplies in an amount not to exceed \$275,000.

6. RECOMMENDATION: Recommend approving use of U.S. Communities contract No. 11019-RFP with Home Depot and HD Supply Maintenance Solutions for the purchase of maintenance and hardware supplies in an amount not to exceed \$275,000.

7. HISTORICAL BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: City departments use Home Depot and HD Maintenance Solutions to purchase miscellaneous lumber and building materials for unforeseen items needed for the day-to-day operation of the City. Some of these items are not purchased on a regular basis and therefore it is not advisable to stock these items in the City's Central Supply warehouse. An example of items being purchased includes lumber, nails, paint brushes, paints, nuts & bolts, cement, bathroom fixtures, hinges, closet doors, cabinets, wall board, garden supplies, etc. As the largest user of this contract, Neighborhood Resources is presenting this item on behalf of all City Departments.

8. EVALUATION PROCESS: Maintenance and hardware supplies have been bid by U.S. Communities with Maricopa County being the lead agency. U.S. Communities is a purchasing cooperative previously approved for use by Council. The use of the U.S. Communities contract eliminates the cost of issuing a bid, reduces the lead-time in obtaining the products, and offers an annual rebate back to the City (from Home Depot). The current contract is due to expire in November of 2011. Maricopa County recently rebid the U.S. Communities contract and is once again acting as the lead agency. The new contract with Home Depot and HD Supply Maintenance Solutions is a three (3) year contract with the option for three (3) additional years. City staff is recommending the utilization of the U.S. Communities contract for a one year period beginning December 1, 2011 for the purchase of maintenance and hardware supplies.

9. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS: Funding for costs associated with this action will be derived from various departments' maintenance, repair, capital and operating supply budgets. The Housing Division will utilize various grant funds from the U.S Department of Housing and Urban Development.

10. PROPOSED MOTION: Move to approve use of U.S. Communities contract No. 11019-RFP with Home Depot and HD Supply Maintenance Solutions for the purchase of maintenance and hardware supplies in an amount not to exceed \$275,000.

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
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
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
