RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends Council forward a recommendation for approval of a Special Event Liquor License for East Valley Jewish Community Center, and further, that approval be given for the City of Chandler Special Event Liquor License.

DISCUSSION

An application for a Special Event Liquor License has been submitted by the East Valley Jewish Community Center for "Get Reel with Director Bryan Singer" a Holocaust Museum Project Fundraiser on Saturday, January 14, 2012 from 6:00 p.m. until 11:00 p.m. located at the Chandler Center for the Arts, 250 N. Arizona Ave.

With a Special Event Liquor License the organization can sell all alcoholic beverages within the confines of the event during the designated event periods.

The Police Department reports no objections to the issuance of this license. As this applicant is a non-profit organization, no sales tax license is required; however, the special event liquor fee has been paid.
