**RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends Council forward a recommendation for approval of a Special Event Liquor License for the Chandler Cultural Foundation, and further, that approval be given for the City of Chandler Special Event Liquor License.

**DISCUSSION**

An application for a Special Event Liquor License has been submitted by the Chandler Cultural Foundation for the Lorrie Morgan & Pam Tillis Fundraiser Concert on Saturday, February 4, 2012 from 5:30 p.m. until 9:30 p.m., located at the Chandler Center for the Arts, 250 N. Arizona Ave.

With a Special Event Liquor License the organization can sell all alcoholic beverages within the confines of the event during the designated event periods.

The Police Department reports no objections to the issuance of this license. As this applicant is a non-profit organization, no sales tax license is required; however, the special event liquor fee has been paid.
