7. HISTORICAL BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: The current contract for police towing will expire on June 30, 2012. Staff had intended to award a new contract prior to that expiration. However, at City Council's direction, Staff will be issuing a new solicitation with increased emphasis on quality.

Staff is requesting approval of Amendment 12, which will extend the contract six months through December 31, 2012 to allow time to complete a new solicitation. Staff will conduct a new procurement process with input from the towing industry and the Public Safety subcommittee.

8. EVALUATION PROCESS: Staff believes extending the existing contract is the best way to ensure that this critical service is provided until a new contract can be awarded.

AMENDMENT NUMBER TWELVE
TO AGREEMENT PD6-968-2247 BETWEEN THE CITY OF CHANDLER
AND ACT TOWING, LLC, DBA ALL CITY TOWING FOR POLICE TOWING

This Amendment Number 12 to that certain Agreement between the City of Chandler (the City) and ACT Towing, LLC, d/b/a All City Towing (Contractor) for police towing dated August 10, 2006 and executed September 1, 2006, (the Agreement) is entered into this ____ day of _____, 2012.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Amendment No. 11 to the Agreement, the contract was extended through June 30, 2012 to permit the City additional time to enter into a new contract for police towing;

WHEREAS, the award of a new contract for police towing will not be completed by June 30, 2012;

WHEREAS, it is essential for public safety to have a contract in place for police towing;

WHEREAS, the City believes that award a new contract for police towing will require a minimum of (6) months; and

WHEREAS, Contractor is willing to extend the Agreement six months (6) months.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and obligations set forth herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. The Agreement, as amended by Amendment Numbers 1 through 11, is hereby extended through December 31, 2012.
2. All terms and conditions in the Agreement, as amended through Amendment Numbers 1 through 11, that are not specifically amended by this Amendment No. 12, shall remain in full force and effect.
