5. SUBJECT: Utilization of State Contract ADPS-11-000307 for the purchase of annual maintenance for existing Automated Fingerprint Identification System/Livescan equipment from MorphoTrak, Inc. in the amount of \$75,140.

6. RECOMMENDATION: Recommend approval of the utilization of State Contract ADPS-11-000307 for the purchase of annual maintenance for existing Automated Fingerprint Identification System/Livescan equipment from MorphoTrak, Inc. in the amount of \$75,140.

7. HISTORICAL BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: The Chandler Police Department's (CPD) Forensic Services Section analyzes all information obtained at all Livescan locations, all 10 print cards and all latent fingerprints recovered from crime scenes prior to being uploaded to the state Automated Fingerprint Identification System (AFIS). The State utilizes MorphoTrak exclusively for this equipment and they are the sole provider of maintenance for this system.

8. EVALUATION PROCESS: The State of Arizona has negotiated and awarded a sole source contract to MorphoTrak, Inc. because their equipment is used exclusively throughout the state to provide automated fingerprint equipment and related maintenance. Because MorphoTrak, Inc. is the sole provider of the equipment, they are the sole provider for the support and maintenance.

9. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS: Funds for this purchase are available in General Fund, Police Forensic Services, Office Equipment Maintenance, 101.2021.5411.
