SUBJECT: RESOLUTION NO. 4541 AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT (IGA) WITH THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ADOT) FOR THE CITY TO PERFORM MINOR MAINTENANCE OF ROADS, SOUND WALLS, SWEEPING, AND GRAFFITI REMOVAL/PAINTING LOCATED WITHIN THE ADOT RIGHT-OF-WAY.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends Council pass and adopt Resolution No. 4541 authorizing the City to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with the Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) for the City to perform minor maintenance of roads, sound walls, sweeping, and graffiti removal/painting located within the ADOT right-of-way.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: Since the opening of the Price Freeway in December 2000 and the Santan Freeway between 2003 and 2005, the City has been maintaining the frontage roads and interchanges along the Price Frontage Road within the ADOT right-of-way. The activities include emergency maintenance, routine maintenance, and scheduled road repair. The City has been sweeping these same locations along the ADOT right-of-way as an added measure of City air quality.

City control over these roads allows Chandler to provide better inspection, quality assurance, and maintenance across jurisdictional boundaries between the City and ADOT. It also allows the City to provide a better response time and excellent service to our residents.

This IGA will formalize an agreement that has been on-going for more than 10 years. The total cost of all additional maintenance is estimated at an average of \$19,000 per year over the five (5) year permit period for both labor and materials. Minor road maintenance procedures shall include asphalt crack seals, fog seals, micro seals, and minor asphalt repairs. Minor concrete



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repairs shall be provided on sidewalks, curb and gutter, and sound walls. Sweeping of streets and removal of graffiti/painting on City facing features shall similarly apply.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:

Cost: \$19,000 average per year over the five (5) year permit period for additional labor and materials to provide preventative maintenance.

Savings: None

PROPOSED MOTION: Move to adopt Resolution No. 4541 authorizing the City to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with the Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) for the City to perform minor maintenance of roads, sound walls, sweeping, and graffiti removal/painting located within the ADOT right-of-way.

WHEREAS, the City of Chandler desires to maintain control of Road Maintenance within the Arizona Department of Transportation's (ADOT) right-of-way to ensure seamless operation across jurisdictional boundaries, and;

WHEREAS, the ADOT has agreed to allow the City of Chandler operation of minor Road Maintenance, Concrete Maintenance, Sweeping, and Graffiti Removal/Painting and;

WHEREAS, the City of Chandler will be required to maintain these roads, and features and;

WHEREAS, an IGA is required by the City and ADOT to specify the responsibilities between the parties;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chandler, Arizona, that the Mayor be authorized to sign and execute said amended Intergovernmental Agreement on behalf of the City of Chandler.

INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
Master Roadway Maintenance

BETWEEN
THE STATE OF ARIZONA
AND
THE CITY OF CHANDLER

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into _____, 2012 pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes, § 11-951 through § 11-954, as amended, between the STATE OF ARIZONA, acting by and through its DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (the "State") and the CITY OF CHANDLER, an Arizona Municipal Corporation (the "City"). Collectively herein referred to as the "Parties".

THIS AGREEMENT, relative to the roadway elements included herein, will work in concert with the agreements listed below. In the event questions arise pertaining to roadway maintenance, this Agreement will take precedence. In the event questions arise pertaining to "Specialized Materials/Features" requested and constructed on behalf of the City, the agreements listed below will take precedence as to the responsibility of maintenance/operation of those specialty items.

I. RECITALS

1. The State is empowered by Arizona Revised Statutes § 28-401 to enter into this Agreement and has delegated to the undersigned, the authority to execute this Agreement on behalf of the State.
 2. The City is empowered by Arizona Revised Statutes § 48-572 to enter into this Agreement and by resolution approved by the City Council (copy attached hereto and made a part hereof) has resolved to enter into this Agreement and has authorized the undersigned to execute this Agreement on behalf of the City.
 3. It is to the mutual benefit of the State and the City to enter into an Agreement specifying their respective construction, operation and maintenance responsibilities concerning certain State highway routes which are encompassed within the City's system of streets and which form necessary and convenient links in the State highway system.

4. The portions of the State Highway System within the City covered by this Agreement are as follows:

- I-10 – Also known as the Phoenix-Casa Grande Interstate
- SR 101L – Also known as the Price Freeway
- SR 202L – Also known as the Santan Freeway
- (EXCLUDES State Route 87 – See JPA 85-010 and JPA 11-016 (upon execution))

THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual Agreements expressed herein, it is agreed as follows:

II. DEFINITIONS

“Blanket Permit” – means only routine/ minor maintenance and emergency maintenance work provided by the City within the State’s rights of way. This permit will be provided at no cost or at a cost established by the Governor or State Legislature in accordance with State Law. No new construction or installation shall be permitted under this permit.

“Crossroads” - means any references to existing or new local streets or arterials that cross the State highway.

“Design Standards” - means the standards that were incorporated into the facility when it was designed and constructed. If the City specifies a design that is not in conformance with State design standards, the City will be responsible for the operation, maintenance and cost reimbursement for the replacement of that material. (Also see *“Specialized Material Features and State Standards”* definitions).

“Frontage Road” - means roadways generally parallel to the State highway mainline, which provides access to severed property and/or collect and distribute traffic between local streets and highway interchanges.

“Hazardous Material Incidents” - means the uncontrolled, un-permitted release or potential release of hazardous materials that may present an imminent and substantial danger to the public’s health or welfare, or to the environment.

“Intersection” - means an area shared by two or more roads, whose main function is to provide for the change of route directions. In this Agreement one of the two roads is a State highway, and the other road is a local crossroad.

“Limited Rehabilitation” - generally refers to minor restorative and/or reconstruction activities. However, for the purpose of this document, such rehabilitation, and/or reconstruction activities undertaken by the City, shall be limited to areas not to exceed 100 square feet in size per repair for paving (a cap of 2,500 square feet per year), 50 linear feet in size per repair for curb, gutter and sidewalk, required only in areas identified as City responsibility.

“MUTCD” - means *Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices*; latest edition as published by Federal Highway Administration (FHWA).

“Operations” - means the performance of practical work or practical application of the principles or processes used to carry out maintenance activities discussed in this Agreement and conducted by the responsible party.

“Parties” - means the State and the City, collectively.

“Party” - means the State or the City, as the case may be.

"Routine/Minor Maintenance" - means that work necessary to maintain feature and area responsibility consistent with maintenance service levels adopted by the responsible party. The defined features/areas include: street surfaces, shoulders, curbs, sidewalks, and median dividers of cross roads, bridges, screen and sound walls, and surface drainage features feeding into the State's drainage system. The responsibility for the routine minor maintenance of the defined areas will include preventative and limited rehabilitation activities such as sweeping, crack sealing, removal of spills and debris, graffiti removal, repair of potholes, minor signing, pavement markings, leveling and/or patching of asphalt concrete pavement with premix, minor seal coating of oxidized pavement, litter and trash removal, minor repair of the surface/base of damaged pavement presenting a safety hazard, and weed removal within designated areas (not covered in a separate landscape maintenance Agreement) of established rights of way. A further listing of these and other responsibilities are detailed within the Roles and Responsibilities, herein referred to as Exhibit A, attached hereto and made a part hereof. The City's areas of responsibility are depicted in the Maintenance Exhibit B, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

"Screen/Sound Walls" - means walls normally built during construction to mitigate noise and visual impacts to a local neighborhood generated by the traffic.

"Specialized Materials/Features" - means decorative materials, special construction materials, or one-of-a-kind features *specifically requested by the City*, which are not required by ADOT specifications. Examples of such features include, but are not limited to: unique icons/patterns, decorative wrought iron fencing, sculptured metal signing, specialized lighting facilities, non-standard paint colors and specialized art features.

"State Standards" - means Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) guidelines, specifications, policies, rules and regulations as of the date of this Agreement for the construction and maintenance of ramps, highways, landscaping, fencing and enclosure structures, drainage and flow structures and other related highway features. These standards will be used unless otherwise agreed to by the parties to this Agreement.

"Transfer of Blue-stake Responsibility" - means the State transfers the responsibility and liability to the City, upon the State's transfer of as-built drawings to the City for blue-staking of all underground facilities and structures that were specifically constructed or operated by the City, but are located in/on State rights of way, other than main line rights of way governed by this Agreement, as blue-staking is defined by Arizona Revised Statutes, *Chapter 2, Article 6.3., Sections 40-360.21 through 40-360.32*.

III. SCOPE OF WORK

1. The State will:

a. Be responsible for the construction, reconstruction, major rehabilitation and/or betterments, of the roadways, curbs, gutters, sidewalks, medians, channelization, drainage facilities - (except where responsibility is defined by separate Agreement), guardrails, walls, chain-link fencing, bridge structures (including pedestrian bridges overpasses and equestrian bridges), drainage, tunnels, and other roadway-related facilities (excluding special traffic signals, wrought iron fencing, certain drainage facilities and special materials requested by the City), generally within the State's access control limits

b. Be responsible for major resurfacing, rehabilitation, and roadway reconstruction treatments including the construction and replacement of all Portland Cement Concrete Pavement (PCCP) roadway surfaces and all asphalt concrete roadway surfaces requiring such activities found within the City's areas of responsibility located within State rights of way, *in excess* of 100 square feet in size for paving and in excess of 50 linear feet in size per repair for curb, gutter and sidewalk.

c. Be responsible for maintenance of all storm drain siphons within State highway rights of way, of which the State is the primary user.

d. Grant or confirm per established procedures of the State's Phoenix Maintenance District Permit Office, that the City has a valid five (5) year citywide Blanket Permit on file for only routine/minor maintenance and emergency maintenance work provided by the City within the State's rights of way. This permit will be provided at no cost or at a cost established by the Governor or State Legislature in accordance with State Law. The State will provide the City with a renewal notice 30-days prior to the end of each 5-year permit term granted to the City. Any new construction or installation shall require a separate permit through the State's Phoenix Maintenance District Permit Supervisor, as per the Phoenix Maintenance District's established procedures.

e. Be responsible for the installation of all initial signing. Maintain all overhead signs structures and large ground-mount guide signs (16 square feet or larger) both in and out of State right of way. Maintain all signs on the frontage roads between the off-ramp gore and the subsequent on-ramp gore.

f. Be responsible for the installation of all initial pavement markings (such as lane lines, edge lines, etc.). Maintain all transverse markings (such as crosswalks, stop bars, etc), and symbol markings (such as turn arrows, "left turn only" words, etc.) at the intersections between the off-ramp gore and the subsequent on-ramp gore.

g. Be responsible for maintaining the structural integrity of sound and screen walls constructed within the State's right of way.

h. Provide structural maintenance to the sub-structure and the superstructure of the bridge and/or tunnel where specialized structures are included: pedestrian bridges, equestrian bridges, overpasses, underpasses and pedestrian tunnels are constructed over/under mainline roadways of the State, excluding the maintenance of all non-standard State items constructed at the City's request as a part of the project.

i. Provide response and clean-up of all hazardous material incidents.

2. The City will:

a. Be responsible for routine/minor maintenance and the limited rehabilitation of all features and asphalt frontage roadway surfaces within the defined areas of the City's responsibility, as depicted in the Maintenance Exhibit B. The defined areas include asphalt street surfaces, shoulders, curbs, sidewalks, median-dividers of crossroads, bridges, and surface drainage features feeding into the State's drainage system. Maintenance of the defined areas will include preventative, routine/minor maintenance and limited rehabilitation activities, including but not limited to such activities as: sweeping, crack sealing, removal of non-hazardous spills and debris, graffiti removal, repair of pot-holes, routine minor maintenance of signing, pavement markings, leveling and/or patching of asphalt concrete pavement with premix, seal coating of oxidized pavement, litter and trash removal, and weed control (where not defined by separate Agreement). The limited rehabilitation repair of subsurface/base of damaged asphalt pavement presenting a safety hazard with such techniques as mill and inlay/overlay, is limited to areas not to exceed 100 square feet in size per repair for paving and 50 linear feet in size per repair for curb, gutter and sidewalk. A further listing of these and other responsibilities are detailed within Exhibit A, the Roles and Responsibilities.

b. Be responsible for maintaining the remaining signs on the frontage roads between the back of the on-ramp gore to the subsequent back of the off-ramp gore, signalized and un-signalized (non-interchange) freeway crossings, according to the maintenance/operational procedures of the City.

c. Be responsible for routine minor maintenance of catch basins, (including vactoring of the catch basin), (*consistent with City maintenance levels*) when such basins are located within the areas where the City is responsible for routine/minor maintenance.

d. Be responsible for routine/minor maintenance of overpasses and underpasses, including pedestrian and equestrian facilities (*consistent with City maintenance levels*). Routine maintenance of these areas will include sweeping, removal of debris and removal of graffiti.

e. Be responsible for maintaining all longitudinal lines (such as lane lines, edge lines, etc.) and median noses on all crossroads and frontage roads using paint, thermoplastic, tape or other materials. City pavement markings responsibilities shall be done according to City adopted standards.

f. Obtain at no cost (per II.1.d above) per established procedures of the State's Phoenix Maintenance District Permit Office, a valid five (5) year citywide Blanket Permit for the routine/minor maintenance and emergency maintenance work provided by the City within the State's rights of way. Any new construction or installation shall require a separate permit as per the Phoenix Maintenance District's established procedures, which may be obtained through the Phoenix Maintenance District Permit Office referenced herein. The City will re-apply for a blanket permit every 5-year term, upon a 30-day notice from the State.

g. Comply with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) (latest edition as published by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA)) and the Arizona Supplement, as per Arizona Revised Statutes §28-641, during all maintenance operations conducted by the City on State highway rights of way. Plans will be reviewed and/or approved by and through the Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT), Phoenix Maintenance District Permits Office.

h. Manage maintenance responsibilities, consistent with established City policy and procedural standards. Notify the State's Traffic Operations Center immediately as provided herein, of any hazardous material incidents occurring within the areas of State-owned rights of way, designated as City's responsibility.

3. The Parties agree:

a. The responsibility for traffic signal and electrical facilities will be as provided by a separate maintenance agreement. Once an un-signalized, freeway/crossroad interchange requires signalization, the entity responsible for maintaining the traffic signal shall also be responsible for the signs, with the exception of overhead signs and large ground mounted signs, 16 square feet or larger, with such signs remaining the responsibility of the State.

b. The maintenance of street lighting and energy costs on non-limited access State routes and non-interchange freeway crossroads and intersections along the freeway frontage roads shall be as provided by a separate maintenance agreement.

c. The maintenance of landscape and related energy costs on non-limited access State routes and non-interchange freeway crossroads and intersections along the freeway frontage roads shall be as provided by a separate maintenance agreement.

d. To maintain the pavement in accordance with the agreed upon PASER Manual (Pavement Surface Evaluation and Rating). The City will maintain the pavement at a rating of 7 or better at a 1-10 scale and the State will be responsible for maintaining the pavement at a rating of 6 or below. The Parties also agree the City's limited rehabilitation will be limited to a cap of 2,500 square feet per year within the City's area of maintenance, starting from the execution date of this Agreement.

e. Where the sound and screen walls delineate the areas between the areas of jurisdictional responsibilities, both Parties will maintain the surface of the wall facing each Party's jurisdiction. The City's maintenance will include graffiti removal, painting and minor surface repair and is delineated between the areas of jurisdictional responsibility. Frontage road areas between the off-ramp gore and the subsequent on-ramp gore are excluded from the City's responsibility, as depicted in the Maintenance Exhibit B. For graffiti removal of underpasses, the City's responsibility will be limited to only the walls facing the City's street.

f. To conduct an annual joint field review and inspection of designated responsibilities to ensure both Parties to this Agreement are executing proper and timely responses to completion of assigned maintenance, commencing annually, coinciding with the date of execution of this Agreement.

g. Upon construction of a new State highway within the City, and upon a mutual signed agreement by the Parties and approval by the Chandler City Council, the new portion of highway shall be incorporated by amendment to this Agreement, prior to completion of any new construction.

h. Upon annexation by the City of any area that is traversed by a State highway, the length of such highway which is within the annexation boundaries shall become subject to the terms of this Agreement, indicating the portion or portions of the State highway affected. This Agreement shall be amended to incorporate the additional area, within 90-days from the time of annexation.

IV. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

1. This Agreement shall become effective upon the signing and dating of the Determination Letter by the State's Attorney General.

2. This Agreement shall remain in full force and effect for successive periods of five (5) years from the effective date and may be amended, upon mutual written consent of both Parties and approval by the City Council, provided however, that this Agreement may be cancelled at any time, with 90 days written notice of either Party. This Agreement shall be reviewed and all reviews shall be completed within 60 days prior to the end of the 5th year anniversary date. If both Parties do not agree with any amendment from this review, the Agreement will renew for the next five (5) year period; the State and the City will continue to negotiate the amendment until an agreement is reached and it is added by Letter Addendum, or if an agreement cannot be reached, the amendment will not be added to this Agreement. If the City initiates a cancellation of this Agreement they then agree to provide the State with the cost of replacement or conversion of all specialty materials and or equipment that does not meet state standards.

3. Each Party (as "indemnitor") agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the other Party (as "indemnitee") from and against any and all claims, losses, liability, costs or other expenses (including, but

not limited to, reasonable attorneys' fees) (hereinafter collectively referred to as "claims") arising out of bodily injury of any person (including death), property damage and any other claims (including, but not limited to, claims of derivative or vicarious liability), which are caused by the act, omission, negligence, misconduct or other fault of the indemnitor, its officers, officials, agents, employees or volunteers.

4. This Agreement may be cancelled by the State in accordance with Arizona Revised Statutes § 38-511.

5. To the extent applicable under law, the provisions set forth in Arizona Revised Statutes § 35-214 and § 35-215 shall apply to this Agreement.

6. **Non-Availability of Funds:** Every payment obligation of the State or the City under this Agreement is conditioned upon the availability of funds appropriated or allocated for the payment of such obligation. If funds are not allocated and available for the continuance of this Agreement, this Agreement may be terminated by the State or the City at the end of the period for which the funds are available. No liability shall accrue to the State or the City in the event this provision is exercised, and the State or the City shall not be obligated or liable for any future payments or for any damages as a result of termination under this paragraph.

7. **Non-Discrimination:** This Agreement is subject to all applicable provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act (Public Law 101-336, 42 U.S.C. 12101-12213) and all applicable federal regulations under the Act, including 28 CFR Parts 35 and 36. The Parties to this Agreement shall comply with Executive Order Number 2009-09 issued by the Governor of the State of Arizona, and incorporated herein by reference.

8. Compliance requirements for Arizona Revised Statutes § 41-4401—immigration laws and E-Verify requirement:

a. The City warrants compliance with all Federal immigration laws and regulations relating to employees and warrants its compliance with Arizona Revised Statutes § 23-214, Subsection A.

b. A breach of a warranty regarding compliance with immigration laws and regulations shall be deemed a material breach of the contract, and the City may be subject to penalties up to and including termination of the Agreement.

c. The State retains the legal right to inspect the papers of any employee who works on the Project to ensure that the City or subcontractor is complying with the warranty under paragraph (a).

9. Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes § 35-391.06 and § 35-393.06, each Party certifies that it does not have a scrutinized business operation in Sudan or Iran. For the purpose of this Section the term "scrutinized business operations" shall have the meanings set forth in Arizona Revised Statutes § 35-391 or § 35-393, as applicable. If any Party determines that another Party submitted a false certification, that Party may impose remedies as provided by law including terminating this Agreement.

10. In the event of any controversy, which may arise out of this Agreement, the parties hereto agree to abide by required arbitration as is set forth for public works contracts in Arizona Revised Statutes § 12-1518, as applicable.

11. All notices or demands upon any Party to this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be delivered in person or sent by mail addressed as follows:



**CITY OF CHANDLER
Maintenance Roles and Responsibility Matrix within State Highway Rights of Way**

ALL ACTIVITIES SHALL BE CONDUCTED ACCORDING TO ADOPTED CITY STANDARDS

ACTIVITIES AND DESCRIPTION:


1. SWEEPING:	Sweeping shall be accomplished when possible during times of low traffic volume.
2. PATCHING WITH PREMIX:	Patching potholes, severe depressions, edge breakup, and breaks in roadway and shoulder surfaces using premix materials.
3. FILL CRACKS WITH ASPHALT RUBBER SEALANT	Route or clean, and fill cracks in bituminous pavements to prevent the passage of water through the surface and into the base sub grade.
4. TIGHT BLADING:	The application of premix with a blade to fill ruts and raveling in asphalt pavement and/or ACFC finishing course. (1 to 1 ½ inches deep or less).
5. FLUSH COAT/FOG SEAL:	Apply emulsified petroleum resin or emulsified asphalt to continuous Sections of asphalt concrete as flush coat to rejuvenate aged asphalt and to retard surface deterioration.
6. EMERGENCY PATCH AND/OR REPAIR:	The emergency repair of asphalt roadway surface/base areas damages presenting a safety hazard to the driving public. The appropriate repair may require the limited rehabilitation repair, requiring the removal and replacement of damaged asphalt sub-surface and deteriorated base. When limited rehabilitation or total reconstruction is required for the areas, City responsibility shall be limited to areas not to exceed 100 square feet in size.
7. REPAIR UNPAVED SHOULDERS:	This activity should be scheduled before rutting along the edge of the pavement effects the integrity of the roadway or when erosion, if left unrepaired, will deteriorate into major damage.
8. FLUSH SHOULDERS EDGE:	Apply emulsified petroleum resin or emulsified asphalt to shoulder edge as a flush coat to rejuvenate aged asphalt and retard deterioration. Apply liquid asphalt and cover material to seal and restore shoulder edge life.
9. MANUAL, MECHANICAL AND/OR CHEMICAL WEED CONTROL	The majority of these activities generally are covered by separate agreement. However, some areas of State rights of way remain City responsibility. Exemplified by: weeds found on the City side of access control fences, weeds or other types of vegetation growing, around drainage basins, within cross - over streets, or pedestrian sidewalks in underpass areas. The specific methods of vegetation control must comply with State and Federal environmental rules and regulations.
10. DEBRIS AND LITTER PICK-UP:	Clean litter and debris from both roadway and City areas of rights of way responsibility, as identified in the Maintenance Exhibit "B". This activity will be undertaken when debris affects the motoring public, when work is necessary to preserve the aesthetic appearance of the highway and necessary to assure the safety of maintenance employees, public and contract, working in the zones of responsibility.

<p>11. CATCH BASINS/ ROUTINE MAINTENANCE:</p>	<p>Cleaning of catch basins within the areas where the City is responsible for the routine and minor maintenance of the roadway surfaces.</p>
<p>12. MINOR SLIDE REMOVAL:</p>	<p>Removal of minor rock and or mud slides as required, insuring that drainage ditches and/or roadway shoulders are free from hazardous conditions.</p>
<p>13. BLUE STAKE :</p>	<p>The City shall be responsible for blue staking utility features that solely serve the City, yet are constructed within state rights of way. This responsibility shall become effective upon Blue Stake operations center notification.</p>
<p>14. ENCROACHMENT PERMITS:</p>	<p>Management of right of way encroachments on non-limited access State routes according to applicable statutes; issuing encroachment permits and notices of illegal encroachments as authorized by law will be the responsibility of the City. Copies of the encroachment notices and permits, including sketches showing exact locations of the encroachments, will be forwarded to the State. Forms and encroachment permits will be furnished by the State.</p>
<p>15. PRIVACY & SOUND WALL MAINTENANCE:</p>	<p>Unless covered by separate agreement for wall maintenance where privacy walls are constructed on the right of way line or the line of delineation between State and City responsibilities, the City will be responsible for maintaining the surface of the side of the wall facing their jurisdiction. Maintenance activities will include graffiti removal, painting and minor surface repair. Sound wall structural integrity will remain the responsibility of the State.</p>
<p>16. PAVEMENT MARKING MAINTENANCE</p>	<p>The City will maintain all longitudinal lines, (such as lane lines, edge lines, etc.) and median noses on all crossroads and frontage roads using paint, thermoplastic, tape or other materials. City pavement markings responsibilities shall be done according to City adopted standards.</p>
<p>17. SIGNING MAINTENANCE:</p>	<p>The City shall be responsible for the maintenance of all signing on crossroads of signalized intersections maintained by the city, signing on the frontage roads between the on-ramp and the subsequent off-ramp, and un-Signalized (Non-interchange) freeway crossings. Said maintenance activities shall be done according to City standards.</p>
