5. SUBJECT: Approve the purchase of two MCC7500 dispatch radio consoles from Motorola Solutions utilizing the City of Phoenix/Motorola Master Communications System Agreement (contract # 124391) in the amount of \$131,096.74.

6. RECOMMENDATION: Recommend approval of the purchase of two MCC7500 dispatch radio consoles from Motorola Solutions utilizing the City of Phoenix/Motorola Master Communications System Agreement (contract # 124391) in the amount of \$131,096.74.

7. HISTORICAL BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: Two additional radio dispatch positions were included as part of the scope of the Police Department's Dispatch Center renovation (Project No: PD1202-401) awarded to SDB, Inc. on June 14, 2012. Because of the nature of the equipment being public safety radio equipment, and SDB, Inc.'s inability to purchase under the City of Phoenix/Motorola Master Communications System Agreement as a general contractor, funding will come from the original project funds and the equipment purchased separately by the Police Department.

8. EVALUATION PROCESS: The current city public safety radio infrastructure was purchased and is supported by Motorola Solutions. The purchase of the two additional dispatch positions is needed to augment the current system and the dispatch consoles must be identical in order for them to work concurrently.

9. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS: Funding for this purchase is available in the amount of \$131,096.74 in account 202-2010-6320 (Police Forfeiture-Police Administration-Other Equipment).

10. PROPOSED MOTION: Move to approve the purchase of two MCC7500 dispatch radio consoles from Motorola Solutions utilizing the City of Phoenix/Motorola Master Communications System Agreement (contract # 124391) in the amount of \$131,096.74.
