5. SUBJECT: Drilling for Railroad Well Construction

6. RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends Council award a Construction Contract to Morex Investments LLC, DBA Arizona Beeman Drilling for Railroad Well Drilling, Project No. WA1302-401, in an amount not to exceed \$822,770.00.

7. BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: The 2008 Water, Wastewater, Reclaimed Water Master Plan recommends 74.5 million gallons per day (MGD) of build-out capacity for groundwater wells. As the City's groundwater wells age, it is anticipated well production may decrease by up to three percent per year. To maintain the required capacity, new wells and rehabilitation of existing wells is needed. This project will abandon an existing well and replace it with a well at the Railroad Well site. A construction management services contract for the drilling of the well was brought forward to Council at the October 25, 2012 Council meeting.

8. EVALUATION: On October 23, 2012 two (2) bids were received and the bids opened on October 24, 2012. The bid results were as follows:

The construction contract is scheduled for completion March 31, 2013.
