5. SUBJECT: Extension of Agreement for Purchase of Traffic Signal Equipment

6. RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends City Council approval of Amendment No. 2 to extend Agreement TE2-550-2975 for Traffic Signal Poles & Miscellaneous Hardware to Valmont Industries, Inc., Southwest Fabrication, LLC, Leotek Electronics USA Corporation, and Cem-Tec; for a total not to exceed \$100,000.00.

7. BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: Traffic Engineering requires traffic signal poles, support equipment, and street lighting poles for replacements, new installations, and upgrades to existing intersections. Most replacements are caused by knockdowns resulting from motor vehicle accidents and funds are recovered through the Risk Management Division. Traffic Engineering also supplies the traffic signal poles and mast arms on various intersection improvement projects on both capital improvement projects and development projects. The purchase of this equipment through this agreement will reduce the cost of construction and accelerate the completion of the improvements. The use of this agreement will be on an as-needed basis throughout the year. The term of this contract is September 1, 2013, through August 31, 2014.

8. EVALUATION PROCESS: City Council approved Agreement TE2-550-2975 in an open-bid contract for the purchase of traffic signal poles and miscellaneous hardware in September 2011. The contractors have agreed to extend the contract for the second year with no price increases.
