1. BALLOT MEASURE: Home Rule Res. #4752

ADOPTED Resolution No. 4752 recommending continuation of the Home Rule Local Alternative Expenditure Limitation and placing the issue on the August 26, 2014, Primary Election Ballot.

Almost four years have passed since the voters of the City of Chandler last adopted a Home Rule Local Alternative Expenditure Limitation in November of 2010. To continue with Home Rule, State law requires that the local alternative limitation must be presented to the voters every four years in conjunction with either the primary or general election. Such elections are only held in even-numbered years.

To place this item on the ballot in the fall of 2014, it is required that two public hearings be advertised and held by the City of Chandler. These public hearings were advertised as required. The first public hearing was conducted on April 10, 2014, and the second on April 24, 2014.

After the public hearing of April 24, 2014, the Council must convene a Special Meeting and by two-thirds affirmative vote, decide whether or not to place the proposition on the primary election ballot of August 26, 2014, for the Home Rule Local Alternative Expenditure Limitation to be submitted to the voters of the City of Chandler.
