SUBJECT: LUP14-0007 BOURBON JACKS BAR & GRILL

Request: Liquor Use Permit approval to sell and serve liquor as permitted under a Series 6 Bar License for on- and off-premises sales indoors and within an outdoor patio, and live entertainment indoors

Location: 11 W. Boston Street, Suite 1

Applicant: Lori Rutten, Howdy Partners LLC

This case was continued at the August 14, 2014, Council meeting to allow time for the applicant and Planning Staff to address concerns raised by an adjacent business owner, Shoe Thrill. The adjacent business owner provided Planning Staff and the Bourbon Jacks owners an email with their concerns. See attachment. Most concerns are related to on-site business owner/landlord property management. Planning Staff worked with the business owners and City Staff regarding these concerns. On August 15, 2014, the Bourbon Jacks and Shoe Thrill business owners had a meeting. A key concern was live music and when it occurs. There are now clear expectations and a line of communication between the businesses. See attached joint email from both business owners.

There is an agreement between the businesses to allow live music after 8 p.m. Monday through Saturday and after 5 p.m. on Sundays. There was a charitable event held on a weekend in which the music occurred during the day while Shoe Thrill was open for business. Bourbon Jacks will coordinate other events in advance so as not to affect Shoe Thrill's business. Bourbon Jacks will advise their management that sound checks and start times occur only within the agreed upon hours.

Both businesses discussed concerns about patrons smoking close to business entrance doors. Planning Staff advised that the Smoke Free Arizona law prohibits smoking within 20 feet of an

entrance. Either business can file a complaint on the Smoke Free Arizona website. In addition, Bourbon Jacks can remove any outdoor ashtrays on patio tables and post a "No Smoking" sign. Bourbon Jacks will advise staff and patrons to prohibit smoking within 20 feet of the entrance.

A concern related to the trash containment area is a multi-tenant matter since many businesses use it. Bourbon Jacks will advise their employees to clean up any over-spilled trash, and both businesses will talk with adjacent tenants to bring awareness about keeping the trash area clean. Concerns related to door access, multi-tenant shared bathroom access and the hallway, and cleaning of shared bathrooms was discussed. Bourbon Jacks owners will advise management to be aware and mitigate these concerns. The location of A-frame signs, a hostess podium, and a statue in front will be located so as not to affect pedestrian circulation.

The concern regarding over-serving liquor was discussed and Bourbon Jacks ensured they do not tolerate it and will further educate management and employees on State laws regarding liquor service and work with Police Staff on how to better address these issues. Planning Staff coordinated with Police Staff on these concerns and Police Staff will speak with the business owners to assist them in these matters. Police provided a call summary report, see attachment.

Shoe Thrill does not request any additional zoning conditions or live music restrictions beyond what was previously approved with the Liquor Use Permit and the agreements they have with Bourbon Jacks. See attached correspondence.

RECOMMENDATION

Upon finding the request to be consistent with the General Plan, Planning Commission and Planning Staff recommend approval subject to conditions.

BACKGROUND

The subject site is located west of Arizona Avenue on the south side of Boston Street in Downtown Chandler. In April 2012, the restaurant was approved a Series 12 Restaurant License for liquor inside and on an outdoor patio as well as live entertainment indoors. The Series 12 Liquor License requires at least 40% of gross revenue from the sale of food. The State Department of Liquor Licenses and Control determined this requirement was not met; therefore, the restaurant is requesting a Series 6 Bar License.

The application requests Liquor Use Permit approval to sell liquor as permitted under a Series 6 Bar License within an existing restaurant. A Series 6 Bar License allows the sale and service of all spirituous liquors and off-sale "To Go" privileges.

The restaurant is approximately 2,600 square feet with approximately 67 seats inside and 15 seats outside on a small patio. The interior includes a stage for live music.

Following concerns raised at City Council, Planning Staff recommends additional zoning conditions to ensure live music does not disturb adjacent businesses and area residents.

PUBLIC / NEIGHBORHOOD NOTIFICATION

- The request was noticed in accordance with the requirements of the Chandler Zoning Code.
- The applicant's neighborhood meeting was held on July 10, 2014. No one attended other than the applicant.

- At the time of the memo, Planning Staff is not aware of any concerns or opposition to this request.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

Upon finding consistency with the General Plan, Planning Commission and Planning Staff recommend approval of Liquor Use Permit LUP14-0007 BOURBON JACKS BAR & GRILL, subject to the following conditions:


1. Expansion, modification, or relocation beyond the approved exhibits (Site Plan, Floor Plan, and Narrative) shall void the Liquor Use Permit and require new Liquor Use Permit re-application and approval.
2. The Liquor Use Permit is granted for a Series 6 (Bar License) only, and any change of licenses shall require re-application and new Liquor Use Permit approval.
3. The Liquor Use Permit is non-transferable to other store locations.
4. The site shall be maintained in a clean and orderly manner.
5. Live music and entertainment shall be controlled so as to not unreasonably disturb adjacent businesses and area residents and shall not exceed the ambient noise level as measured at the commercial property line.
6. The establishment shall provide a contact phone number of a responsible person (business owner and/or manager) to interested business owners and neighbors to resolve noise complaints quickly and directly.



PROJECT NARRATIVE

Liquor Use Permit

For its Project Narrative, in accordance with the requirements of the City of Chandler Liquor Use Permit Application, Howdy Partners, LLC dba Bourbon Jacks Bar & Grill states as follows:

Bourbon Jacks Bar & Grill is requesting approval of a Bar Use Permit to allow a series 6 liquor license with live entertainment on the premises and alcoholic beverage and food consumption on the outdoor fenced patio located at 11 West Boston Street, Suite 1 Chandler, AZ 85225 (West of Arizona Avenue on the South side of Boston Street). The existing location previously secured a use permit for a restaurant with alcohol consumption inside and on the fenced patio of the establishment. The restaurant liquor license shall be surrendered upon approval of the required Bar Use Permit allowing live entertainment and approval of a series 6 bar license for this location by the City of Chandler and the Arizona Department of Liquor.

Bourbon Jacks Bar & Grill will continue to sell food at the establishment with the series 6 bar license and will continue live entertainment on the premises as previously approved by the City of Chandler. Therefore, this application is requesting approval of a Liquor Use Permit allowing live entertainment with a series 6 bar license for on-site consumption of alcoholic beverages as well as food inside the establishment and within the fenced outdoor patio which meets the requirements of Arizona Department of Liquor as well as the City of Chandler (previously approved for the restaurant liquor license). Although a series 6 bar license does allow sealed package sales of alcoholic beverages, it is not our intent to sell package goods to go at this time. This type of license does have a minimum distance requirement of 300 feet from churches and schools. However, there are no churches or schools within 300 feet. The closest church is .9 miles (4,752 feet) from Bourbon Jacks Bar & Grill and the nearest school is approximately .5 miles (2,640 feet) away. The consumption of alcoholic beverages at this site will not negatively impact residents or other businesses within the surrounding area, as most adjacent businesses close by 6:00 p.m.

The historical building underwent interior modifications in 2012 to allow restaurant operations with on-site consumption of alcoholic beverages and opened to the public in September of the same year. As previously stipulated, Bourbon Jacks Bar & Grill will continue to offer restaurant services for Lunch and Dinner operating 7 days a week from 11:00 am until 10:00 pm, opening at 10:00 am on Saturday and Sunday for breakfast. There are no changes to the previously approved entertainment related activities which includes live music, outdoor music speakers, and televisions.

Bourbon Jacks Bar & Grill has a large existing clientele due to the quality of the food. The consumption of alcoholic beverages on premises will continue to complement the food service provided by the restaurant. A copy of the existing menu is attached. A small outdoor patio on the north side of the business will be used for food and alcohol consumption. The patio is contiguous with the restaurant and is enclosed with iron fencing. The existing landscaping produces a safe, inviting and aesthetically appealing dining area and was previously approved by the City of Chandler when the Restaurant liquor license use permit was obtained.



Therefore, the issuance of a Use Permit will not disrupt the existing balance of daytime and nighttime uses and will not affect vehicular or pedestrian traffic in the adjacent parking lots as there is adequate parking and entrances/exits to the businesses, and properties on the southwest corner of South Arizona Avenue and West Boston Street.




LUPM-2007 Narrative

Some of their employees park all day in front of the store or in front or in front of Chop Shop They need to park in the parking lot in back and leave these spots for all customers.

The worst offender is a white Honda X-box.....might be a cook.

They are very dirty in many areas that affect us directly. They have garbage that is outside of the garbage can every day. Straws and cut up bar fruit is outside the dumpster on a daily basis and it doesn't get picked up and the straws blow around in stormy weather.

They do not collapse their boxes before throwing away and the garbage gets overfull.

They start their music before the time allowed and it is too loud. We have told them many times this is the case, they seem not to care. It is so loud in our store we cant talk to our customers or each other.

The side walk is crowded with their "Jack" statue the podium that is outside their gated area...making our customers walk around this as well as the menu stand on the sidewalk as well as two chalk boards that take up sidewalk space ad walkways for all customers.

Their customers stand in front of our store to smoke and the smoke from this and the outside smoking in their front patio area does not allow us to open our door without getting it in our store.

Their customers beat up the restrooms and come in our store drunk because they open the door to the common restroom area is left propped open on their part instead of having them use their restrooms.

Their customers beat up our sidewalk chalk board and we told them and they said they would take care of it and they never have.

They put their tables and chairs in our hallway and outside the back door so that we can't even carry out garbage as they block then walk ways as to barfly get by the tables and chairs they move out for dancing on a regular basis. They act like they own the like entire area around them.

They fenced in the area behind their store and also an area that the other common stores use and we used often.

* They prop open the common hall way and their customers hold this door open to let in anyone they want. Big safety issue for our store and employees

* They over serve their customers alcohol on a continuous basis. We have customer that will attest to this as they did it to her husband.

* Rich Thurman of Shoe Thrill was alerted to a drunk and passed out customer in his vehicle in front of our store by one the Bourbon Jacks hostesses.

* Rich ended up calling a cab and paying for the \$40 plus ride home as he could not find a manager to take care of this situation. When Rich did find a manager.....they refused to take responsibility....they denied and questioned everything and would not reimburse Rich for the cab fair for their very drunk and passed out customer.

They are not good neighbors and do not represent the downtown community of Chandler in a positive way.

Attached is the list of issues Rich Thurman of Shoe Thrill provided me last night when he asked me to give him a call. I did call Mr. Thurman this morning and Mr. Radice and I are meeting with him and his wife, Carissa, this afternoon at 2:00 pm. I am not sure of the typical protocol in these situations, but you are welcome to join us if you'd like. We are meeting at Chop Shop.

In speaking with Mr. Thurman this morning to set up the appointment, he expressed that Ms. Krausman did not need to be present, that he and his wife could settle the issues at hand without her. I asked that he please ask her to come because clearly she has concerns that need to be addressed as well. However, at Mr. Thurman's request, we will proceed with our scheduled meeting today without Ms. Krausman but will continue to try and set something up with her in the future. Additionally, I was given the impression by Mr. Thurman that their actions and the City Council hearing last night was an attempt to get our attention, as he expressed that they do not want to or intend to "shut our business down".

I would however like to state that the information they conveyed to the City Council at the hearing last night was not an accurate reflection of our business practices. Nor are the items on the list they provided accurate or solely our responsibility. I feel that it is unfortunate that our neighbor felt it necessary to speak so poorly of us over items that could have certainly been cleared up amongst ourselves.

At any rate, please know that John and I are working diligently to amicably resolve the issues at hand and I will keep you updated on our progress.

Please give me a call so that we can discuss this further and to also let me know how to proceed and what to expect with the next hearing scheduled for September 11, 2014.

Thank you for the email, information and resources.

Rich Thurman, Carissa Thurman, Mary Krausman, John Radice and Lori Rutten had an opportunity to meet Friday afternoon on August 15th. While not everything was addressed or worked out in one sitting, it was agreed that opening the lines of communications between the five parties will have a positive impact on relationships going forward.

After meeting with Ms. Krausman and the Thurman's, John Radice and Lori Rutten had a meeting with the staff at Bourbon Jacks to ensure that their staff is on the same page and to outline expectations going forward.

Ms. Krausman and the Thurman's will be having a similar meeting with their staff late next week.

In regards to the live music, John Radice and Lori Rutten learned that at times the bands have been starting prior to the Shoe Thrill's closing time, especially on Sunday. This concern has been addressed and John Radice and Lori Rutten asked their management to ensure that the bands were not beginning or performing sound checks prior to their scheduled start times.

John Radice and Lori Rutten instructed their staff at Bourbon Jacks to be more diligent in asking customers to not smoke so close to the establishments in hopes to mitigate the effects of those actions. Additionally, Bourbon Jacks staff is going to be more thorough in their cleaning of the common restrooms and the area around the community dumpster.

The doors to the common restroom are going to be labeled to avoid confusion as to what door leads where as well as stating that the door between these facilities and the hallway to the additional center businesses must remain closed at all times. During the Shoe Thrill and Bourbon Jacks meeting it was agreed that that particular doors do get propped open by many of the center's businesses and throughout the course of the evening the staff at Bourbon Jacks will be keeping a better eye on its position to ensure that it remains closed.
