SUBJECT: ANNEXATION – SOUTHWEST CORNER OF QUEEN CREEK ROAD AND UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD
Final Adoption of Ordinance No. 4590

- Request: Annexation of approximately 18.75 acres
Location: Southwest corner of Queen Creek Road and the Union Pacific Railroad
Applicant: Adam Baugh, Withey Morris PLC

Final adoption of this ordinance was continued upon the applicant’s request from the December 8, 2014, Council meeting so that the timing of the annexation can be coordinated more closely with the forthcoming rezoning application.
