5. SUBJECT: Purchase of Network Security Software/Appliance

6. RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends City Council approve the utilization of the Western States Contracting Alliance (WSCA) Contract #ADSPO11-007500, with SHI International Corporation for the purchase of Proofpoint network security software/appliance in the amount of \$176,167.

7. BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: The City of Chandler's data security effectiveness roadmap includes prevention of confidential data loss and prevention of potential data security breaches. Detection, prevention, and encryption technologies help to ensure we are not disclosing information via e-mail messages that could lead to identity theft or data breaches. We are requesting approval for the addition of these technologies to the City's current e-mail security system's to prevent data loss, unintentional exposures as well as the ability to send messages via specific security policies utilizing data encryption. These e-mail hygiene/security appliances and services have been in use since 2005. We are renewing and adding additional protections. We are very satisfied with the protections these appliances and services provided by Proofpoint, Inc.

Securing the City's electronic messaging systems meets liability, risk management, and regulatory compliance objectives. Staff recommends that the City approve the software addition, licensing support and maintenance. This security capability addition and renewal covers the City's ongoing use of the Proofpoint system for a 3-year period.

8. EVALUATION: The State of Minnesota competitively solicited and awarded a contract for software and maintenance services on behalf of the Western States Contracting Alliance (WSCA). The State of Arizona has adopted the WSCA contract and because the City has a current Intergovernmental Agreement with the State, the City makes use of the contract to purchase the annual support and maintenance services for Proofpoint.

Staff recommends the cooperative use of this contract because of the benefit of higher discounts due to the combined large volume purchases.


