5. SUBJECT: Construction Contract to The Fishel Company, for the Reclaimed Water Infill

6. RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends City Council award a Construction Contract to The Fishel Company, for the Reclaimed Water Infill, Project No. WW1414.401, in an amount not to exceed \$1,471,470.

7. BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: Staff identified locations within south Chandler that require reclaimed water infill piping to increase the redundancy of the system and provide reclaimed water service to new users. These areas are located on Alma School Road, between Willis and Germann Roads, and on Arizona Avenue, between Willis Road and Macaw Street.

The project scope of work includes the installation of a 12-inch reclaimed water main and stubs for future services for adjacent parcels along Arizona Avenue and Alma School Road.

A Project Agreement for construction management services, Agreement No. WW1414.451, with AZTEC Engineering Group, Inc., is also scheduled for this Council meeting.

8. EVALUATION: Seven (7) bids were opened on July 16, 2015. The bid results were as follows:

The engineer's estimate for this project was \$1,225,172.78. The construction contract time is 30 calendar days for substantial completion, and 60 calendar days for final completion on Alma School Road. The construction contract time is 120 calendar days for substantial completion, and 150 calendar days for final completion on Arizona Avenue.


