**SUBJECT:** SPECIAL EVENT LIQUOR LICENSE  
 THE BOOT CAMPAIGN

**RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends Council forward a recommendation for approval of a Special Event Liquor License for The Boot Campaign, and further, that approval be given for the City of Chandler Special Event Liquor License.

**DISCUSSION**

An application for a Special Event Liquor License has been submitted by The Boot Campaign for The Great American BBQ & Beer Festival on Saturday, March 19, 2016, from Noon until 10:00 p.m., located at Dr. A.J. Chandler Park, 3 S. Arizona Avenue.

With a Special Event Liquor License, the organization can sell all alcoholic beverages within the confines of the event during the designated event periods.

The Police Department reports no objections to the issuance of this license. The special event liquor fee has been paid; however, as this applicant is a non-profit organization, no sales tax license is required.
