5. SUBJECT: Purchase of BizTalk Server Software Licenses

6. RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends City Council approve the utilization of National Association of State Procurement Officials (NASPO), formerly Western States Contracting Alliance (WSCA), Contract No. ADSPO11-007500, with SHI International, for the purchase of BizTalk Server software licenses, in the amount of \$84,355.

7. BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:

In 2011, the City began a migration to utilizing an Enterprise Application Integration (EAI) solution to provide integrated, centralized interfaces between applications rather than the traditional point-to-point interfaces used in the past. Microsoft BizTalk Server is the City standard EAI application that manages the integration between City enterprise software applications and is now essential to City operations. The City continues to expand the use of the application as it enhances integrations for many applications.

The City is currently running BizTalk Server 2010. Microsoft discontinued mainstream support for this version in January of 2016 and only provides security updates and fixes to issues identified prior to that date. The need to upgrade this software was identified and a decision package was approved in the FY15-16 budget. The current version is BizTalk Server 2013. Microsoft will provide mainstream support for the 2013 version until July of 2018. Included in this purchase is Software Assurance that will protect the City's investment by granting the City access to the next version of the BizTalk Server software and extending the support lifecycle for several more years at no additional cost.

8. EVALUATION: The State of Minnesota competitively solicited and awarded a contract for software and maintenance services on behalf of the National Association of State Procurement Officials (NASPO). The State of Arizona has adopted the NASPO contract and because the City has a current Intergovernmental Agreement with the State, the City makes use of the contract to purchase various software licenses.

Staff recommends cooperative use of this contract because of the benefit of higher discounts due to the combined large volume purchases.




