RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends Council forward a recommendation for approval of a Special Event Liquor License for Chandler Cultural Foundation, and further, that approval be given for the City of Chandler Special Event Liquor License.

DISCUSSION

An application for a Special Event Liquor License has been submitted by Chandler Cultural Foundation for the Get the Led Out event on Sunday, September 25, 2016, from 5:00 p.m. until 9:00 p.m., located at Chandler Center for the Arts, 250 N. Arizona Avenue.

With a Special Event Liquor License, the organization can sell all alcoholic beverages within the confines of the event during the designated event periods.

The Police Department reports no objections to the issuance of this license. The special event liquor fee has been paid; however, as this applicant is a non-profit organization, no sales tax license is required.
