SUBJECT: RESOLUTION NO. 5012 AUTHORIZING A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY FOR THE UASI ASSESSMENT TEAMS – FIRE TERRORISM LIAISON OFFICER EQUIPMENT AND TRAINING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$6,930

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends City Council pass and adopt Resolution No. 5012, authorizing the City of Chandler to enter into a Grant Agreement with the Arizona Department of Homeland Security (AZDOHS) for the UASI Assessment Teams – Fire Terrorism Liaison Officer equipment and training in the amount of \$6,930.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: The City of Chandler established a Fire Terrorism Liaison Officer program in 2003 with federal funding from the State Homeland Security Grant program. This program ensures Fire, Health & Medical Department personnel are prepared and equipped to respond to large scale emergencies, terrorist events, and natural and/or man-made disasters. The above listed award is being made under the 2014 State Homeland Security Grant Program. The purpose of the award is to provide equipment and training to sustain the Terrorism Liaison Officer program.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS: This grant has no match requirements. Chandler Fire, Health & Medical has the appropriation allocation in the FY 2016/17 Budget.

PROPOSED MOTION: Move that City Council pass and adopt Resolution No. 5012, authorizing the City of Chandler to enter into a Grant Agreement with the Arizona Department of Homeland Security (AZDOHS) for the UASI Assessment Teams – Fire Terrorism Liaison Officer equipment and training in the amount of \$6,930.

RESOLUTION NO. 5012

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHANDLER, ARIZONA, PERTAINING TO THE ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT FROM THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY UNDER THE HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM ENTITLED 2016 URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE (“UASI”) ASSESSMENT TEAMS – FIRE TERRORISM LIAISON OFFICERS.

WHEREAS: The Arizona Department of Homeland Security (AZDOHS) through the 2014 State Homeland Security Grant Program provides financial assistance directly to fire departments to ensure that they are prepared and equipped to respond to large scale emergencies, terrorist events and natural and/or man-made disasters.

WHEREAS: The City of Chandler Fire, Health & Medical Department (CFHMD) established a Rapid Response Team and Terrorism Liaison Officer program in 2003 with federal funding from the AZDOHS.

WHEREAS: The CFHMD submitted a request for grant funding to the AZDOHS for the 2016 Urban Area Assessment Teams – Fire Terrorism Liaison Officers.

WHEREAS: The AZDOHS has informed the CFHMD that it is eligible for \$6,930, with no matching funds requirement.

WHEREAS: The CFHMD has determined that it can comply with the terms of the Grant Application Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chandler, Arizona follows:

1. THAT the City shall accept 2016 Urban Area Assessment Teams – Fire Terrorism Liaison Officers funding from the AZDOHS in the amount of \$6,930, and shall comply with the Grant Agreement requirements.
2. THAT the CFHMD Fire Chief take such actions necessary to implement the provisions of this Resolution No. 5012.
