

ABOUT THE EEC

The Environmental Education Center is an 11,000 sq.-ft. facility featuring classrooms, exhibits, live animals and a nature store, and is the gateway to Veterans Oasis Park. The Center offers year-round recreation programming for all ages, with an emphasis on nature, science, and the environment. In addition to room rentals, the EEC also offers party packages and volunteer opportunities!

Veterans Oasis Park covers 113 acres and features both lush wetland and arid habitat suitable for the diverse plants and wildlife of the Sonoran Desert. The park also includes 4½ miles of trails; wildlife viewing areas; pavilions and picnic areas; a butterfly and hummingbird habitat; an outdoor amphitheater; a unique, learning-oriented playground; a 5-acre urban fishing lake; and interpretive signs and exhibits.

PARK PAVILION RESERVATIONS

Host your next birthday party, barbecue, or picnic at Veterans Oasis Park! All of the park's pavilions are close to the Urban Fishing Lake and include accessible facilities and barbecue grills. The cost to reserve a pavilion is \$3 per hour for Chandler residents and \$5 per hour for non-residents (rates subject to change).


PAVILION USE RULES:

- Pavilions are available on a first-come, first-served basis unless already reserved.
- Pavilions may be reserved during regular park hours (daily 6 a.m.-10:30 p.m.). There is no minimum hourly reservation requirement.
- Reservations must be made in advance at the Environmental Education Center during regular business hours or by phone: 480-782-2890.
- No moon bounces, jumpers, amplified sound, or glass containers allowed.
- Bicycle, skateboard, and rollerblade use are not permitted in the pavilions.
- Alcohol permits are available for purchase inside the Environmental Education Center for \$10.
