(145 total surveys mailed, 17 received, 5 returned (vacant), 123 no response)

The Action Committee of Central Chandler Neighborhood is a Traditional Neighborhood located at the southeast corner of Arizona Avenue and Pecos Road. The first homes in the neighborhood were built in the 1930s. This is an opportunity to take an inventory of existing conditions and identify the neighborhood characteristics that make the neighborhood desirable and identify those issues that negatively impact the neighborhood.
