- Workshop I - Know Your City Resources**
Wednesday, April 24, 2013 **6:00 pm – 8:00 pm**
- Participants will receive an overview of their City resources and learn how to develop positive relationships with their City government leaders.
- *Note: This class will take place at Chandler City Hall - Council Chambers, 88 E. Chicago Street*
- Workshop II - You and Your Neighborhood**
Wednesday, May 1, 2013 **6:00 pm – 8:00 pm**
- Participants will identify key components of a neighborhood and determine the boundaries and characteristics of their neighborhood. Participants will be guided through a personal neighborhood assessment exercise. Participants will learn about the resources available for leaders to expand communication throughout their neighborhoods & will develop a survey that will help them better understand their neighborhood needs and concerns.
- Workshop III - Neighborhood Leadership**
Wednesday, May 8, 2013 **6:00 pm – 8:00 pm**
- Participants will discuss the characteristics of an effective leader. Participants will learn the importance of building relationships and partnerships with other leaders in the community for the betterment of their neighborhood. Participants will discuss neighborhood identity and learn about Neighborhood Grants available to assist with various neighborhood conditions.
- Workshop IV - Moving Forward with Your Neighbors**
Wednesday, May 15, 2013 **6:00 pm – 8:00 pm**
- Participants will prepare and present the outcomes of their neighborhood survey and develop action steps to lead their neighbors into action for the betterment of their neighborhood.
