Workshop I - You and Your Neighborhood
Wednesday, Sept. 30

6 – 8 p.m.

Participants will identify key components of a neighborhood and determine the boundaries and characteristics of their neighborhood.

Participants will also learn about the resources available for leaders to expand communication throughout their neighborhoods and develop a survey that will help them better understand their neighborhood needs and concerns.

Workshop II - Neighborhood Leadership & Identity
Wednesday, Oct. 7

6 – 8 p.m.

Participants will learn the importance of building relationships and partnerships with other leaders in the community for the betterment of their neighborhood and discuss the characteristics of an effective leader.

Participants will also discuss neighborhood identity and brainstorm ideas to develop logos that are representative of their neighborhoods as the first step in the development of neighborhood street signs.

Workshop III - Know Your City Resources
Wednesday, Oct. 14

6 – 8 p.m.

Participants will receive an overview of City resources and learn how to develop positive relationships with their City government.

Workshop IV - Moving Forward with Your Neighbors
Wednesday, Oct. 21

6 – 8 p.m.

Participants will prepare and present the outcomes of their neighborhood survey and develop action steps to lead their neighbors into action for the betterment of their neighborhood.

Participants will also be guided through the process of hosting their first neighborhood meeting to discuss the results of the survey with their neighbors and develop an effective neighborhood action plan.
