Qualifications:

- Must be 13-17 years old
- Must be available Mondays, 1-3 p.m. for workshops and Tuesdays through Fridays during the hours of 8 a.m.-noon or 1-5 p.m. for work
- Must have a strong work ethic with a good attitude and willingness to learn
- Must be present the entire six weeks of the program
- Must have transportation to and from work site and workshops
- Attend the "Future Leaders Fair" on Monday June 20, 2016 1-3 p.m.
