5. SUBJECT: Extension of contract number RO4-485-2095 for control of aquatic insects and odor at the Reverse Osmosis brine evaporation ponds for an additional one-year term to Aquatic Consulting & Testing, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$63,000.

6. RECOMMENDATION: Recommend extending contract number RO4-485-2095 for control of aquatic insects and odor at the Reverse Osmosis brine evaporation ponds for an additional one-year term to Aquatic Consulting & Testing, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$63,000.

7. HISTORICAL BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: The City of Chandler's Reverse Osmosis Facility maintains a 32-acre brine evaporation pond site near Gilbert and Ocotillo Roads. Several housing developments are located in close proximity to the evaporation ponds. Residents of nearby developments have expressed concern over midge fly nuisances. A midge fly is a small, non-biting insect that resembles a mosquito. This contract will help reduce the aquatic insects and odor problem.

8. EVALUATION PROCESS: Council approved a one-year contract with four one-year extensions in April 2004 to Aquatic Consulting & Testing, Inc. to help reduce the aquatic insects and odor problem. Aquatic Consulting & Testing, Inc. has agreed to extend the contract without a price increase. Staff is satisfied with the services provided by the current contractor and is requesting a second one-year extension. By renewing the contract, the City is avoiding administrative costs associated with re-bidding.
