6. RECOMMENDATION: Recommend approval to use Houston Galveston Area Cooperative for the purchase of a regenerative air street sweeper from Tymco International LTD, in an amount not to exceed \$156,621.91.

7. BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: On October 25, 2006 Maricopa Association of Governments (MAG) Regional Council approved the prioritized list of proposed PM-10 certified street sweeper purchases for fiscal year 2007. The City of Chandler was informed that our sweeper was authorized for grant funding. This sweeper meets all current MAG environmental requirements. The grant amount is a maximum of \$164,464.

This sweeper will be used to sweep primarily the south portion of the City and continue to support the current level of service for all of Chandler.

8. EVALUATION PROCESS: The requested equipment has been bid by the Houston Galveston Area Cooperative. By using this contract the City will save costs and time of the bid process. A purchase order will be used as the contract.

9. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:

Cost: \$156,621.91

Savings: \$146,088.93 (MAG Grant)

Long Term Costs: General maintenance costs of approximately \$4,400/year
