**5. SUBJECT:** Recommend approval for the sole source purchase of the Checkpoint access control system and closed circuit surveillance and TV system for the Chandler Heights Police substation building and secure parking area, utilizing APL Access & Security, in an amount of \$75,988.22.

**6. RECOMMENDATION:** Recommend approval for the sole source purchase of the Checkpoint access control system and closed circuit surveillance and TV system for the Chandler Heights Police substation building and secure parking area, utilizing APL Access & Security, in an amount of \$75,988.22.

**7. HISTORICAL BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:** Request includes equipment for installation of the Checkpoint access control system and closed circuit surveillance and TV system for the Chandler Heights Police substation. This request includes a main controller, terminal controller, key pads, proximity readers, door release system, wire conduit, fittings, door contacts, digital video recorder for 24 hour recording up to a year, cameras, mounts, monitor, racks and associated materials needed for installation of access control and security cameras. This equipment and installation is technical in nature and requires high security, which APL provides. Sole Source Justification: In August of 1997, an administrative regulation (60-1) was approved making the Checkpoint access system the proprietary provider for the City of Chandler.

Because APL Access & Security is the only authorized Threshold NT client server Checkpoint dealer in Arizona, Checkpoint has agreed to give the City a 15% discount on all Checkpoint hardware and software through APL Access & Security.

Although there are four (4) Checkpoint distributors in the valley, APL is the only distributor certified to work on Threshold NT, the Microsoft based operating system. Checkpoint will only warranty products that have been installed or serviced by a certified NT distributor.

APL Access & Security has the necessary security clearance and ability to install and maintain this high tech/ high security system, which is a continuation of the closed circuit surveillance and TV system they are installing as part of access and security for the police building.

**8. EVALUATION PROCESS:** Security and access for City of Chandler facilities has been awarded to APL Access & Security as a sole source provider. The following is a breakdown of the costs:

Material: (Checkpoint access)	\$30,916.00
Sales Tax: (7.80%)	\$ 2,411.45
Material: (close circuit TV)	\$39,574.00
Sales Tax: (7.80%)	\$ 3,086.77
Total:	\$75,988.22

The installation will be simultaneous with the security and access control, interview rooms, jail cameras and outside security. This request is for materials only.






