5. **SUBJECT:** Approve a one-year extension for job order contract JOC 05-01 to Arizona Beeman Drilling in an amount not to exceed \$1,500,000, for well drilling and rehabilitation services.

6. **RECOMMENDATION:** Staff recommends that Council approve a one-year extension for job order contract JOC 05-01 to Arizona Beeman Drilling in an amount not to exceed \$1,500,000, for well drilling and rehabilitation services.

7. **BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:** The development of new water production well sites and the rehabilitation of existing well sites is required to provide water to meet the City's future demand. In addition, the development of aquifer storage and recovery (ASR) wells is required to support the reclaimed water distribution system. This job order contract provides for drilling and rehabilitation services for diagnostic, monitoring, ASR, and water production wells. Under this contract, individual project agreements will be prepared for execution and approval for each specific project.

8. **EVALUATION PROCESS:** Arizona Beeman Drilling was selected for a one-year contract with an option to renew for two additional years. The original contract was awarded May 12, 2005. This is the second contract extension and third and final year of job order contract JOC 05-01.

9. **FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:** Based on projected needs, staff anticipates that as much as \$1,500,000 will be expended under this well drilling and rehabilitation job order contract. Those project agreements exceeding \$50,000 will be brought forward to Council for approval.

10. **PROPOSED MOTION:** Move that Council approve a one-year extension for job order contract JOC 05-01 to Arizona Beeman Drilling in an amount not to exceed \$1,500,000, for well drilling and rehabilitation services, and authorize the Mayor to sign the contract documents.
