5. SUBJECT: Approval of the utilization of Maricopa County contract #05128 to purchase from the County digital aerial images in an amount not to exceed \$32,471.38.

6. RECOMMENDATION: Recommend approval of the utilization of Maricopa County contract #05128 to purchase from the County aerial images in an amount not to exceed \$32,471.38.

7. HISTORICAL BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: Aerial imaging services are required to create the Citywide aerial photography and update the associated geographic information system (GIS) control data. These services are used to support the City's GIS, provide planning data for studies such as flood control, city growth, utilities systems, as well as data for CIP projects, emergency services, and master planning, and update the aerial information for the City's InfoMap.


8. EVALUATION PROCESS: Aerial Imaging Services has been bid by Maricopa County and a contract has been awarded to Sanborn Map Company. The use of this contract for the purchase of digital aerial images eliminates the cost of issuing a bid and results in lower costs due to other agencies sharing the cost of the imaging services. A purchase order will be used as the agreement to purchase these images. Council has approved the form of the purchase order as well as an intergovernmental agreement with the State of Arizona.
