5. SUBJECT: Approve utilization of Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) Contract No. T0620A0032 for the purchase of paint for pavement marking from Pervo Paint Co. through use of purchase orders in an amount not to exceed \$50,000.

6. RECOMMENDATION: Recommend approval of the utilization of ADOT Contract No. T0620A0032 for the purchase of paint for pavement marking from Pervo Paint Co. through use of purchase orders in an amount not to exceed \$50,000.

7. BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: The Traffic Engineering division has an on-going program to restripe all arterial and collector roads in the City. This includes repainting of longitudinal lines, including lane lines, centerlines, and bike lanes. It also includes restriping of transverse lines, including stop bars, crosswalks, arrow symbols, and railroad crossings. It is estimated that 5,300 gallons of paint (3,500 gallons of white paint and 1,800 gallons of yellow paint are needed).

8. EVALUATION PROCESS: The requested supplies have been bid by ADOT in 2006. By utilizing the ADOT contract, the City will save costs associated with the bid process and have the opportunity to participate in discounts not normally available to the City. A purchase order will be used as a contract.
