5. SUBJECT: Approve use of Arizona State contract for Medical and Chemical Waste Disposal Services with Clean Harbors Environmental Services, Inc. in amount not to exceed \$121,000.

6. RECOMMENDATION: Recommend use of Arizona State contract for Medical and Chemical Waste Disposal Services with Clean Harbors Environmental Services, Inc. in amount not to exceed \$121,000.

7. HISTORICAL BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: In fiscal year 2005-06, Chandler constructed a household hazardous waste (HHW) collection facility located at the Recycling-Solid Waste Collection Center. Throughout the year, this facility provides Chandler residents with convenient, safe recycling and disposal of household products containing chemicals.

In fiscal year 2006-07, the HHW facility diverted approximately 125,000 pounds of pesticides, flammables, oxidizers, batteries, etc. Staff works closely with the contractor to ensure safe and proper handling. This professional service is required to ensure regulatory compliance.

8. EVALUATION PROCESS: The State of Arizona bid this requested service. The City will avoid the costs of the bid process by using the State contract. The State contract is in effect through May 31, 2008 and is extendable through May 31, 2011.

9. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:

Cost: \$121,000
Savings: Potential for further reducing costs associated with landfill disposal and environmental clean-up due to improper disposal


