5. SUBJECT: Approve the use of Dysart Unified School District Contract #0506-018 with Sunland Asphalt to reconstruct the basketball courts at Amberwood Park, Mountain View Park, Price Park, and Pecos Ranch Park in the amount of \$202,302.83.

6. RECOMMENDATION: Approve the use of Dysart Unified School District Contract #0506-018 with Sunland Asphalt to reconstruct the basketball courts at Amberwood Park, Mountain View Park, Price Park, and Pecos Ranch Park in the amount of \$202,302.83.

7. HISTORICAL BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: Amberwood Park, Mountain View Park, Price Park, and Pecos Ranch Park are all neighborhood parks that have existing asphalt basketball courts. All of the basketball courts are at least 13 years old and have extensive damage. Each year, the Community Services Department has received several requests to repair the basketball courts. After several unsuccessful attempts to repair the courts, it has been determined that they must be replaced. The new courts will be post tension concrete slabs, which provide an excellent, durable playing surface.

8. EVALUATION PROCESS: The Dysart Unified School District issued a cooperative bid for Construction, Repair, and maintenance of Asphalt and Concrete Surfaces. An award was made to Sunland Asphalt. The Parks Division has received pricing under this contract from Sunland Asphalt to reconstruct existing basketball courts at four (4) parks. Work will include the removal, repair and/or replacement of vegetation, landscaping, irrigation and electrical lines at Amberwood Park, Mountain View Park, Price Park, and Pecos Ranch Park. By utilizing the Dysart Unified School District contract, the Parks Division is able to expedite the reconstruction of the basketball courts.

9. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS: Funds for this service will be from the General Obligation Bonds Fund, Existing Neighborhood Park Improvements, account number 420.4580.0000.6611.8PR049 in the amount of \$202,302.83.
