5. SUBJECT: Award a construction contract to Nesbitt Contracting Co., Inc. for Asphalt Mill and Inlay, Project No. ST0805-401, in an amount not to exceed \$1,644,207.60.

6. RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends that Council award a construction contract to Nesbitt Contracting Co., Inc. for Asphalt Mill and Inlay, Project No. ST0805-401, in an amount not to exceed \$1,644,207.60.

7. BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: The Streets Division staff has field-evaluated over seven centerline miles of streets that were identified for rehabilitation by the City's pavement management system. The rehabilitation of these streets will use the mill and inlay process. The mill and inlay of a street becomes necessary when the existing pavement condition is such that the street can no longer be properly maintained with slurry seal or micro seal applications.

The rehabilitation will occur along 90 sections of residential and collector streets, as well as one section of Ray Road between Dobson Road and Arrowhead Drive. These streets are located within the areas shown on the attached map. This work is expected to start in February 2008 and be completed by fall 2008. Access to residences and business will be maintained at all times.

8. EVALUATION: On November 28, 2007, six (6) bids were received and opened on November 29, 2007 with the results as follows:

Grey Mountain Construction, LLC	\$1,899,724.10
Sunland Asphalt	\$1,997,337.90

The City staff estimate was \$1.8 million, derived using unit prices from the previous mill and inlay contract with an inflationary factor applied. The total contract time is 365 calendar days to provide the Streets Division with flexibility in the project schedule. City staff will provide construction inspections.




