SUBJECT: WINDROSE EAST HOA MATCHING GRANT

RECOMMENDATION: Neighborhood Programs staff and the Neighborhood Advisory Committee recommend approval of the Windrose East HOA matching grant request in the amount of \$500.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: Windrose East HOA is located north of Ray Rd. and west of Arizona Ave. The 12-year-old association has applied for grant funds to host a block party in conjunction with its annual meeting in January. The block party will consist of food, drinks, and activities for the kids. Windrose East HOA is a small subdivision with 66 homes. Over time, many of the original owners have sold their homes to investors who now use the properties as rentals. One of the goals of the block party is to encourage renters and homeowners to meet each other and work together.

The total budget for the block party is \$1,000. The residents plan to complete the required 250 commitment hours by gathering neighborhood volunteers to assist with the planning and preparation of the neighborhood event.

Members of the Grant Review Committee and Neighborhood Advisory Committee have reviewed the grant application and recommend approval.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS: HOA Matching Grant Funds have been budgeted and are available.



PROPOSED MOTION: Move to approve the Windrose East HOA grant request in the amount of \$500.
