CITY hereby gives notice of the exercise of its option to extend the AGREEMENT for one year pursuant to the same terms and conditions as the AGREEMENT.





5. SUBJECT: Approve a one (1) year extension to the existing annual pipeline design contract, EN0711-101, with Morrison-Maierle, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000.

6. RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends that Council approve a one (1) year extension to the existing annual pipeline design contract, EN0711-101, with Morrison-Maierle, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000.

7. BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: The City contracts with a consultant to provide water and wastewater pipeline design services for miscellaneous pipe replacement projects not related to larger street projects. The design contract is utilized on a limited basis for design work to replace aging or inadequate piping as necessary. The relatively small size of the projects and fees do not warrant the expense of a consultant selection for each project.

8. EVALUATION: The consultant was selected for a one-year contract with an option to renew for four additional years. This contract extension will be the first option year of the annual survey contract EN0711-101. The annual contract with Morrison-Maierle, Inc., was approved by Council on August 23, 2007.


