7. HISTORICAL BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: During main repairs and replacements it is necessary to completely shut down water service to successfully complete work without excessive loss of water. It is also important to prevent damage to structures and other utilities within the area. The City of Chandler Water Distribution Division will use this contract to make emergency valve repairs and/or replacements when identified during a main break. Funds for this contract will be spent on an as needed basis.

8. EVALUATION PROCESS: The requested service has been bid by the City of Scottsdale and by using this contract, the City of Chandler will save costs associated with the bid process. A purchase order will be used as the contract.
