**7. HISTORICAL BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:** This contract will provide all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to slurry seal, re-stripe, repair, replace, reseal and seal coat the parking lots and driveways at the Fire Training Facility, Fire Administration, Municipal Courts and the Planning & Development buildings. Staff inspected all city facilities and a priority list was developed based on the conditions found during the inspection. The facilities listed in this contract are those considered to need immediate attention.

**8. EVALUATION PROCESS:** The Dysart Unified School District issued a cooperative bid for construction, repair, and maintenance of asphalt and concrete surfaces on behalf of the S.A.V.E. Purchasing Cooperative. An award was made to Sunland Asphalt. By utilizing the Dysart Unified School District contract, the Parks Division is able to expedite the repairs for the parking areas.

**9. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:** Funds for this service will be from the Existing Community Facility Improvements account 101.4580.6611.9PR628.
