5. SUBJECT: Approve utilization of Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) Contract No. T0620A0032 for the purchase of traffic striping paint from Pervo Paint Co. for one-year in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.

6. RECOMMENDATION: Recommend approval of the utilization of Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) Contract No. T0620A0032 for the purchase of traffic striping paint from Pervo Paint Co. for one-year in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.

7. BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: The Traffic Engineering Division has an on-going program to restripe all arterial and collector roads in the City once per year. This includes repainting of longitudinal lines, including lane lines, centerlines, and bike lanes. It also includes restriping of transverse lines, including stop bars, crosswalks, arrow symbols, and railroad crossings. It is estimated that 14,000 gallons of paint (9,200 gallons of white and 4,800 gallons of yellow) are needed. The 2009 prices are identical to the 2008 prices, and are \$6.93/gallon of white, and \$7.14/gallon of yellow paint. This is a water-based paint that is fast drying and is used by ADOT and other valley cities.

8. EVALUATION PROCESS: Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) bid the requested supplies in 2006 with options to renew for four (4) additional one-year periods. This is the final renewal. By utilizing the ADOT contract, the City will save costs associated with the bid process and have the opportunity to participate in discounts not normally available to the City. Because ADOT purchases large volumes of traffic striping paint every year, the bid pricing on the ADOT contract is likely better than if we bid the paint ourselves. A purchase order will serve as our contract.


