5. SUBJECT: Approve use of City of Peoria contract with Peoria Pest Control for treatment of manholes in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.

6. RECOMMENDATION: Recommend approval to use City of Peoria contract with Peoria Pest Control for treatment of manholes in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.

7. HISTORICAL BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: The City has 16,538 sewer manholes. The insecticide paint used in manholes is warranted for two years. Municipalities, which were once exempt from the state laws governing pesticide licensing and application, are now required to obtain these licenses to apply pesticides. Municipal Utilities determined the most cost effective solution for controlling roaches in City owned manholes is to engage the services of a licensed exterminator to apply insecticide paint to the manholes. Wastewater Collection plans to paint one-half of the City owned manholes each year.

8. EVALUATION PROCESS: The requested service has been bid by City of Peoria. Using the City of Peoria contract will save City of Chandler costs associated with the bid process. A purchase order will be used as the contract.


