5. **SUBJECT:** Approval to purchase annual maintenance for existing Automated Fingerprint Identification System/Livescan equipment from MorphoTrak (formerly Sagem Morpho) utilizing State contract #SCC060002 in an amount not to exceed \$64,001.

6. **RECOMMENDATION:** Recommend approval to purchase annual maintenance for existing Automated Fingerprint Identification System/Livescan equipment from MorphoTrak utilizing State contract #SCC060002 in an amount not to exceed \$64,001.

7. **HISTORICAL BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:** The Chandler Police Department's (CPD) Forensic Services Section analyzes all information obtained at either of the Livescan locations, all 10 print cards and all latent fingerprints recovered from crime scenes prior to being uploaded to the state Automated Fingerprint Identification System (AFIS). The State utilizes MorphoTrak exclusively for this equipment and they are the sole provider of maintenance for this system.


8. **EVALUATION PROCESS:** The purchase of this maintenance has been competitively bid by the State of Arizona. Sagem Morpho was originally awarded a contract to provide automated fingerprint equipment and maintenance and the State has accepted the contractor's name change to MorphoTrak. The use of this contract eliminates the cost of issuing a bid and provides for competitive pricing.

9. **FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:** Funds for this purchase are available in General Fund, Police Forensic Services, Other Equipment 101-2021-5411.


