5. SUBJECT: Approval to use Houston-Galveston Area Cooperative for the purchase of a street sweeper from TYMCO International in an amount not to exceed \$181,622.18.

6. RECOMMENDATION: Recommend approval to use Houston-Galveston Area Cooperative for the purchase of a street sweeper from TYMCO International in an amount not to exceed \$181,622.18.

7. BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: On September 1, 2009 Maricopa Association of Governments (MAG) Regional Council approved the prioritized list of proposed PM-10 certified street sweeper purchases for fiscal year 2009. The City of Chandler was informed that our sweeper was authorized for grant funding. This sweeper meets all current MAG environmental requirements. The grant amount is a maximum of \$209,097; Chandler is required to match at least 5.7% of the grant.
This sweeper will be a replacement sweeper for an older PM-10 compliant sweeper for the east side of Chandler.

8. EVALUATION PROCESS: In November of 2007 City Council approved use of the Houston-Galveston Area Cooperative. The requested equipment has been bid by the Houston-Galveston Area Cooperative. By using this contract the City will save costs and time of the bid process. A purchase order will be used as the contract.
