5. SUBJECT: Amendment 1 to extend the two-year contract WA8-968-2461 for the purchase of Arsenic Filter Media from Severn Trent Water Purification Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$2,500,000.

6. RECOMMENDATION: Recommend approval of Amendment 1 to extend the two-year contract WA8-968-2461 for the purchase of Arsenic Filter Media from Severn Trent Water Purification Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$2,500,000.

7. HISTORICAL BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: In 2006, Municipal Utilities began operating treatment systems to remove Arsenic from drinking water at eight well sites, as required by Federal law. The systems include pressurized vessels that contain absorbent media that removes Arsenic from water. Periodically the media must be replaced to ensure continued compliance with drinking water standards.

The City has experience with four different media originally offered. One product failed within three months, one media did not have County approval, and the third showed no evidence of successful use in the field. The Severn Trent product is the most cost effective media because it has the highest treatment capacity and was the least expensive.

8. EVALUATION PROCESS: In March 2008, Council awarded a two-year contract WA8-968-2461 for the purchase of Arsenic Filter Media to Severn Trent Water Purification Inc. The contract was awarded with provisions to extend for two additional two-year periods.
