Reserve one of the lakeside ramadas at Veterans Oasis Park! All park ramadas are close to the Urban Fishing Lake and include accessible facilities, and some have barbeque grills. Veterans Oasis Park is a perfect place to host your next gathering! The cost to reserve a ramada is \$3 per hour for residents and \$7 per hour for non-residents. Ramada Use Rules:

- Ramadas are available on a first-come, first-served basis unless already reserved.
- Reservations must be made in advance at the Environmental Education Center.
- No moon bounces, jumpers, or amplified sound allowed.
- Bicycle, skateboard and rollerblade use is not permitted in the ramadas.
- Glass containers are prohibited.
- A malt beverage permit is required for alcohol use in the park.

OWL'S NEST NATURE STORE Inside the Environmental Education Center at Veterans Oasis Park



LOOKING FOR A NEW PLACE IN CHANDLER TO RIDE YOUR HORSE?



Then come visit Veterans Oasis Park, a 113-acre park located on the northeast corner of Lindsay and Chandler Heights roads. The designated horse trails running through the park are accessible through V-notches or horse step-over gates in the fence at three of the park's access points. Horseback riding is only allowed on these designated trails, and riders must ride in from outside areas, as there is no horse trailer parking nor loading/unloading of horses allowed within the park itself.
